Dear Governor Owens:

I am honored to submit the 2000 Annual Report (Report) on behalf of the Colorado Division of Banking (Division) for all Colorado state chartered commercial banks, industrial banks, and trust companies, as required by the provisions of Sections 11-2-110, 11-22-109.6, and 11-23-118, C.R.S. The Report also contains information on money order companies licensed by the Division, and other comparative financial information.

The financial services industry recorded another year of strong growth and record earnings. Although there was some decline in asset quality at a few institutions, overall asset quality remained very good. Average equity capital of state chartered banks increased from 7.99 percent to 8.41 percent as of December 31, 2000. State chartered commercial banks, industrial banks, and trust companies reported aggregate net income of \$285 million during 2000, an increase of more than 18 percent over 1999 earnings. Moreover, the aggregate earnings of this group has increased 52 percent since 1996.

The rate of industry consolidation has continued to slow; however, the total number of state chartered commercial banks, industrial banks, and trust companies declined from 135 to 130 during the year. Interest in new bank charters has remained strong. One new commercial bank was chartered in 2000, and Division representatives met with the organizers of three other proposed banks whose applications were to be filed in early 2001. Total deposits held by state chartered commercial banks increased 9.98 percent to \$14,446,565,000, and total assets increased by 9.22 percent to \$16,587,555,000 as of December 31, 2000.

Total deposits held by the four state chartered industrial banks increased 3.15 percent to \$396,618,000, and total assets increased 5.14 percent to \$662,238,000 as of December 31, 2000. Total equity of the industrial banks increased 8.67 percent to \$99,097,000.

In late 2000, one large Colorado trust company relocated from Denver to Atlanta in conjunction with an overall corporate restructuring. As a result, total trust assets reported by the nine Colorado trust companies declined during the year from \$72,664,233,000 to \$46,297,810,000, a decrease of 36.29 percent. The industry reported total assets of \$2,459,144,000, as of December 31, 2000, a decrease of 3.79 percent over the prior year. Despite the asset declines, the trust companies reported net income of \$49,054,000 for the year, a 53 percent increase over the preceding year.

I trust the information presented in the Report is helpful to you and your staff.

Division Mission and Structure

The Division is responsible for the regulation of state chartered commercial banks, trust companies, industrial banks, money order companies, money transmitters, and foreign capital depositories. The Division holds charter and license application hearings and issues rules and regulations affecting regulated institutions. Division staff conduct examinations of state chartered institutions and licensees. The Division works closely with the Federal Reserve Bank and the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in the regulation of commercial banks and industrial banks and certain federally insured trust companies. The Division is also responsible for the enforcement of the Public Deposit Protection Act to protect public entity deposits held by state and national banks.

The eight-member Colorado State Banking Board (Banking Board) is the policy and rulemaking authority for the Division. The Banking Board consists of four members who are executive officers of state banks, an executive officer of an industrial bank, an executive officer of a trust company, and two public members. The Governor appoints Banking Board members to four-year terms. Section 11-2-102, C.R.S. requires a balanced membership with respect to political party affiliation, and geographic location. The Banking Board conducts monthly meetings that are open to the public, and the public is encouraged to attend.

The State Bank Commissioner is the administrative head of the Division, responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Division, including personnel matters, records, reports, systems, and procedures. The Commissioner is also responsible for all examination and enforcement functions of the Division, subject to the policy-making and rulemaking authority of the Banking Board. The specific duties and powers of the Commissioner are set forth in Section 11-2-106, C.R.S.

The Division currently has 38 authorized employees, 25 of whom are in the Financial Credit Examiner (FCE) category. Of the 25 FCE classifications, 18 are field examiners, 4 are portfolio managers, one is an automation specialist, one manages applications and complaints and one is Director of Examinations. The Division also employees two electronic data processing (EDP) auditors to conduct EDP examinations of financial institutions and data centers that provide EDP services to Division-regulated institutions. Other positions include a Director of Operations and administrative and support staff.

The Division is organized into two units, *Examinations* and *Operations*. Within the *Examinations Unit*, supervisory and examination responsibilities for the regulated entities are assigned to four portfolio managers. The portfolio managers supervise examination teams and are the primary Division contact for institutions. The *Operations Unit* is responsible for applications, automation, policies and procedures, examination scheduling, enforcement of the Public Deposit Protection Act, program development, training, internal audit and review, oversight of the administrative staff, and accreditation by the Conference of State Bank Supervisors.

Accreditation, Audit and Sunset Process

The Division's operations are independently reviewed through an accreditation process administered by the Conference of State Bank Supervisors (CSBS). The accreditation program involves annual self evaluations in accordance with a CSBS developed questionnaire and rating system, complemented by an on-site review conducted by a CSBS review team every five years. During 1996, the Division underwent a rigorous self-examination and on-site review by a CSBS review team. The Division's processes, products, and personnel were evaluated and rated and the Division was re-accredited at that time. The Division is scheduled to undergo another onsite review in August of 2001. The accreditation process not only provides an independent review of Division operations, but also identifies areas for improvement and provides comparisons to other state banking departments. In addition, CSBS accreditation is one factor used by


federal regulatory agencies in determining the acceptability of state examinations pursuant to interagency agreements and alternating state/federal examinations.


Division operations and programs are also subject to periodic reviews by the Office of the State Auditor. The State Auditor completed a performance audit of the Division's administration of the Public Deposit Protection Act in March 2000. The report identified areas to improve and strengthen the program, which recommendations have been, or are in the process of being, implemented by the Division.


As proscribed by statute, the Department of Regulatory agencies performs Sunset reviews of the functions of the Commissioner and Banking Board with respect to regulatory programs. The results of the review and recommendations are provided to the Colorado General Assembly. If the General Assembly does not pass legislation extending such regulation, the program is repealed by operation of law. Regulation of debt management companies by the Division was not extended by the 62nd General Assembly and the regulatory program was discontinued effective July 1, 2000. The Division itself is subject to a Sunset review pursuant to Section 11-2-101(10)(a), C.R.S., in 2004.

Division Budget and Funding

The Division operates on a July 1 to June 30 fiscal year and is cash funded in advance through semi-annual institution assessments, specialty examination charges, and receipt of application and licensing fees. The Division's approved budget for the 2000-2001 fiscal year was \$3,242,664. The assessment rates and fee structure are reviewed and approved by the Banking Board. Institution assessments are the primary funding source. The assessment consists of a base amount plus a sliding scale percentage of assets over an established level. The calculation formula is based on projected funding needs less application and examination fees. A breakdown of the Division's budget as well as trend information for revenues, assessment base, and the cash fund balance are depicted in the following charts.








Reserve Fund Balance

Legislation enacted in 1998 (SB 98-194) requires cash funded agencies having a cash fund balance in excess of 16.5 percent of expenditures as of June 30, 1998, to reduce fees as necessary to lower the cash fund balance to 16.5 percent of expenditures, or less, by the end of the 2000-01 fiscal year. The Division had historically maintained its cash fund balance at higher levels in order to cushion unexpected revenue variances from application fees and other sources, and thereby minimize fluctuations in the assessment calculation. However, with the passage SB 98-194 the Division has gradually reduced its cash fund to achieve an internal target of not more than 10 percent of expenditures and ensure that the legislative cap is not inadvertently exceeded. It is estimated that the Division's cash fund balance as of June 30, 2001, will be approximately \$300,000 below the 16.5 percent cap.





The Colorado economy remained strong during 2000 despite definite signs of slowing in the national economy. As reported in the December 6th issue of the Colorado Economic Chronicle, key economic indicators for Colorado such as nonfarm employment growth, the unemployment rate, retail trade sales, and home prices were all rated as good. Only nonresidential construction was adversely rated. This strong economy supported another year of strong growth and record earnings by the financial services industry. Although there was some decline in asset quality at a few institutions, overall asset quality remained very good. Average equity capital of state chartered banks increased from 7.99 percent to 8.41 percent as of December 31, 2000. State chartered commercial banks, industrial banks, and trust companies reported aggregate net income of \$285 million during 2000, an increase of more than 18 percent over 1999 earnings. Moreover, the aggregate earnings of this group has increased 52 percent since 1996.



Interest in new bank charters remained strong. One new commercial bank was chartered in 2000, and Division representatives met with the organizers of three other proposed banks whose applications were to be filed in early 2001. One new trust company was approved, and two new money transmitter licenses were issued during 2000. Finally, the Division processed the first foreign capital depository application submitted in accordance with the Foreign Capital Depository Act that was enacted in 1999.

Commercial Banks

Assets held by state chartered banks increased 9.2 percent to \$16,587,555,000 as of December 31, 2000. The asset growth was supported by a \$182,183,000 increase in equity capital and a \$25,830,000 increase in net income over the previous year. The following three charts depict the changes in number, total assets, and total equity of state chartered commercial banks over the ten-year period ending December 31, 2000.









Industrial Banks

The industrial bank charter was created a number of years ago to fulfill a financial need that, at the time, commercial banks were prevented by law from satisfying--making second mortgage loans. Industrial banks belonged to the Industrial Bank Guaranty Corporation, a statutorily created entity that assessed members to provide an insurance fund for depositors. At one time, there were approximately 150 industrial banks in Colorado. However, that number diminished through consolidations, conversions, and failures, and currently four industrial banks remain in Colorado. The financial difficulties experienced by industrial banks in the 1980s resulted in the insolvency of the Industrial Bank Guaranty Corporation and prompted the Colorado General Assembly to dramatically amend the Industrial Bank Act, and require industrial banks to obtain FDIC insurance. Statutory and regulatory differences between industrial banks and commercial banks have been largely eliminated.

Total assets of industrial banks declined dramatically during the late 1980s, but stabilized in 1992 and have increased steadily since that time. Although the number has dwindled, the remaining industrial banks are financially strong and the industrial bank charter remains a viable charter option.








Trust Companies

State chartered trust companies provide a variety of fiduciary services including traditional managed trust business, administering self-directed IRA or pension funds, and administration of collective investment funds. Trust companies are authorized to invest in loans, but are prohibited from originating loans. Legislation enacted in 1989 allows state chartered trust companies to become federally-insured depository institutions authorized to accept and maintain savings deposits, time deposits, and certificates of deposit. Only trust companies and state and nationally chartered banks authorized to offer fiduciary services are permitted to conduct trust company business in Colorado. There are currently three depository trust companies and six non-depository trust companies in Colorado.

In late 2000, one large Colorado trust company relocated from Denver to Atlanta in conjunction with an overall corporate restructuring. As a result, total trust assets reported by the nine Colorado trust companies declined substantially during the year as reflected in the following graph. However, despite the asset declines, total equity of the industry continued to increase, and net income increased by 53 percent over the preceding year.







Money Order Companies

There are twenty-three organizations licensed under Colorado's Money Order Act. With the exception of governmental organizations and insured financial institutions, licensing is required of any organization selling money orders or travelers checks, or any organization transmitting money in Colorado. The total dollar amount of money transmitted, and exchange sold or issued in Colorado during 2000 by Colorado licensed money transmitters was over \$18 billion, an increase of 46.9 percent over 1999.
