Subject: Colorado's Electronic Prescription Drug Monitoring Program ("PDMP")

Pursuant to CRS 12-22-706(3), the Colorado State Board of Pharmacy must report annually to the Health and Human Services Committee of the Senate and House of Representatives detailing the gifts, grants, and donations requested, and the amounts received to maintain the PDMP.
