Subject: Colorado’s Electronic Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (“PDMP”)

Pursuant to CRS 12-280-405(2), the Colorado State Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) must report annually to the Health and Human Services Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives detailing the gifts, grants, and donations requested, and the amounts received to maintain the PDMP. CRS 12-280-405(2) requires the Board to seek gifts, grants and donations on an annual basis for the purpose of maintaining the PDMP and to annually report the results to your respective committees.

In 2020, no money was received for maintenance of the PDMP from solicited organizations. Funds were unsuccessfully solicited from the following:


