For the year July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC) took the following actions in compliance with § 24-76.5-101 et seq.:

Verified identification documents and received affidavits of lawful presence for 281 sole proprietor applicants seeking permits, registrations or stamps from the PUC. Evidence presented and accepted as proof of US citizenship or lawful presence in the United States includes:
