During the calendar year 2021, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC) took the following actions in compliance with § 24-76.5-101 et seq.:

Verified identification documents and received affidavits of lawful presence for 158 sole proprietor applicants seeking permits, registrations, or stamps from the PUC. Evidence presented and accepted as proof of US citizenship or lawful presence in the United States includes:

• US Military ID	0
• Certificate of Naturalized Status	12
• Certificate of US Citizenship	3
• Valid Immigration Document	1
• Colorado Driver’s License/ID	126
• Other Acceptable Driver’s License/ID	16
• Department of Revenue Waiver	0

Notes:

1. Applicants other than sole proprietorships are not subject to the review and verification process.
2. Pursuant to Senate Bill 21-077 (Remove Lawful Presence Verification Credentialing), the information noted above is reflective of lawful presence data collected from January 1, 2021 through September 7, 2021 (the effective date of the changes implemented by the aforementioned bill).
