PUC Annual Report, 4 CCR 723-6-6020, 2020

This report, as required by 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-6-6020 is submitted to the Public Utilities Commission and to the Director of the Commission and posted on the Public Utilities Commission's (PUC or Commission) website. Each section represents a separate line item of the report tied to the rule requirement. Report statistics are by Calendar Year (CY). The reason for CY reporting is related to rule 6020 (b) and (c) as derived from statistics reported by all Common Carriers(Taxi, shuttles, etc.) in their annual reports filed with the Commission.

Important definitions to remember while reading this report include:

"Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity", "Certificate", or "CPCN" means the Authority issued to a Common Carrier declaring that the present or future public convenience and necessity requires or will require the stated operation.

"Common Carrier" is a public utility as defined in § 40-1-102, C.R.S., and includes the obligation to indiscriminately accept and carry Passengers for Compensation. Common Carrier includes every Person directly or indirectly affording a means of transportation, or any service or facility in connection therewith, within this state, by Motor Vehicle; except that the term does not include a Contract Carrier as defined by § 40-10.1-101(6), C.R.S.; a Motor Carrier that provides transportation not subject to regulation pursuant to § 40-10.1-105, C.R.S.; a Limited Regulation Carrier defined by § 40-10.1-301, C.R.S.; a Large Market Taxicab Service defined by § 40-10.1-101(9.5) C.R.S.; and a Transportation Network Company defined under § 40-10.1-602, C.R.S.

"Contract Carrier" means every Person, who, by special contract, directly or indirectly affords a means of Passenger transportation over any public highway of this state; except that the term does not include a Common Carrier defined in § 40-1-102, C.R.S.; a Limited Regulation Carrier defined in § 40-10.1-301, C.R.S.; a Transportation Network Company defined in § 40-10.1-602, C.R.S.; or a Large Market Taxicab Service defined in § 40-10.1-101(9.5), C.R.S.

"Limited Regulation Carrier" means a Person who provides service by Charter Bus, Children's Activity Bus, Fire Crew Transport, Luxury Limousine, Medicaid Client Transport, or Off-Road Scenic Charter as those terms are defined in § 40-10.1-301, C.R.S. and rule 6301.

"Permit" means the Permit issued to: a Contract Carrier pursuant to part 2 of Article 10.1 of Title 40, C.R.S.; a Limited Regulation Carrier pursuant to part 3 of Article 10.1 of Title 40, C.R.S.; a Towing Carrier pursuant to part 4 of Article 10.1 of Title 40, C.R.S.; a Household Goods Mover pursuant to part 5 of Article 10.1 of Title 40, C.R.S.; a Transportation Network Company pursuant to part 6 of Article 10.1 of Title 40, C.R.S.; a Large Market Taxicab Service carrier pursuant to part 7 of Article 10.1 of Title 40, C.R.S.; a Hazardous Materials Carrier pursuant to Article 20 of Title 42, C.R.S.; or a Nuclear Materials Carrier pursuant to Article 20 of Title 42, C.R.S.


At least once every twelve months, or more frequently if requested by the Commission, the Commission staff shall provide a report to the Commissioners and to the Director of the Commission of the financial results (for Fully Regulated Intrastate Carriers), the operational performance of Motor Carriers regulated by these rules as well as the enforcement and compliance actions taken by Enforcement Officials. The first report is due July 1, 2019. The financial and operational report shall include the following:

- (a) number of existing and new Certificates and Permits (by type) issued in the current year as well as the previous four years by Type of Service and geographical area;
- (b) total amount of revenue as reported on the Annual Report for the current year and the previous four years for each Common Carrier as well as revenue in the main geographic areas of the state;
- number of trips to Denver International Airport and revenue generated for the current year and each of the last four years for each of the Common Carriers or Contract Carriers or Large Market Taxicab Service providers;
- (d) total number of Motor Vehicle Identification Stamps issued for the current year and for each of the previous four years as well as the amount of annual revenue generated from the stamps;
- (e) the total number of UCR Plan registrations each year as well as the previous four years;
- (f) number of Authorities suspended, revoked, or abandoned in the current year and each of the previous four years and a summary of the reasons for such status;
- (g) number of Permits (but not Contract Carrier permits) expired, canceled, or revoked in the current year and each of the previous four years;
- (h) number of vehicle inspections conducted by Enforcement Officials in the current year and each of the previous four years by type (vehicles 10,000 pounds or less and 15 Passenger or less and Commercial Vehicles 10,001 pounds or more and 16 Passengers or more) and a summary of the types of deficiencies noted;
- (i) safety and compliance reviews for the current year and each of the past four years; investigations opened and closed;
- (j) number of CPANs issued (by type) and the amount collected for the current year and each of the previous four years;
- (k) refunds to customers for current year and each of the past four years;
- (I) violation warnings issued for current year and each of the past four years;
- (m) number of petitions for age waivers for each year and the previous four years, action taken by the Commission, and age of vehicles and mileage for petitions granted and denied;
- (n) recommendations as to what if any changes should be made to the current rules of the Commission; and
- (o) recommendations as to the priority for the type of enforcement actions for the next year.
- (p) The report shall be provided to each of the Commissioners and the Director and shall be posted on the website of the Commission.

(n) recommendations as to what if any changes should be made to the current rules of the Commission.

Based on the transportation rulemaking, Proceeding No. 17R-0796TR, and the resulting rules that went into effect on May 15, 2019, iln June of 2019, the Taxi Coalition of Driver filed a Petition for Rulemaking in Proceeding No. 19M-0346TR. The Commission accepted the Petition seeking relief regarding Rule 6110, Hours of Service (HOS) regarding the 12 hours-on and 12 hours-off rule, but denied the Petition on the proposed relief from Rule 6254 regarding Flat Rate Zones. The Commission sought comment from industry. There was overwhelming support to open another rulemaking regarding the HOS rules. An additional rulemaking is anticipated to address these HOS relief to return to an alternative HOS limitations of ten hours driving, 15 hours on duty and 70 hours in eight days. When this rulemaking is opened and NOPR published, it will be an opportunity to address Commercial Vehicle inspections and petitions for age waivers as currently the rules establish a 15-year age limit without a waiver from the Commission, annual Stamp Show Cause revocation procedures, and other areas of concern. Staff is preparing to issue a NOPR once the towing rules (Proceeding No. 19R-0709TO) and booting rules (Proceeding No. 19R-0709TO) and booting rules (Proceeding No. 19R-0485TR) are complete.

On January 16, 2019, the Towing & Recovery Professionals of Colorado (TRPC) submitted a Petition (19M-0049TR) requesting the Commission open a rulemaking regarding the Commission's Rules Regulating Tow Carriers, 4 CCR 723-6. On March 14, 2019 at the Commissioner's Weekly Meeting, the Commission denied the Petition.

In Decision No. C19-0267, dated March 25, 2019, the Commission, in its Decision denying this Petition for Rulemaking, opened a separate Miscellaneous Proceeding (19M-0140TO) for the purpose of gathering industry comment and directed Staff to conduct stakeholder meetings. The Commission sought further stakeholder input on whether it is appropriate to re-open these rules for amendment so soon after the last rulemaking (see Proceeding No. 16R-0095TO). The Commission also requested stakeholder input the various positions of existing rules and determination as to whether consensus interpretation and understanding of existing rules could be achieved. On May 23, 2019, Commission Staff held a stakeholder meeting with interested parties at the PUC office. There were approximately 20 towing industry members present. Based on that stakeholder input, the Commission issued a NOPR (Proceeding No. 19R-0709TO) for towing rulemaking addressing among other things, whether the rates allowed by Rule 6511should be tied to an index to allow for reasonable increases in towing rates. A recommended decision is pending from the hearing officer.

In response to legislation in SB19-236, the Commission issued a NOPR (Proceeding No. 19R-0485TR) for the regulation of the booting industry. A series of public comments hearings were held and a recommended decision is pending from the hearing officer.

(o) recommendations as to the priority for the type of enforcement actions for the next year.

Staff recommends continuing its efforts to identify and address illegally operating carriers (those without authorities or permits and no insurance on file with the PUC) and to remain focused on the towing industry violations. In 2019, towing complaints comprised over 50 percent of all complaints received at the PUC as compared to all other industries combined. Given that the majority of complaints are from consumers involving the non-consensual towing of a personal vehicle, consumers need immediate relief when that vehicle is in storage accumulating storage fees. Staff remains focused on resolving those issues related to recovery of their vehicles to provide the owners some continuity to return to work or other needed use of the vehicle.

Note: Due to retirements and separations in the transportation enforcement branch (turnover of over 75 percent of personnel in the last 18 months), staff is has hired personnel to fill vacancies based on available funding and working to train new personnel on enforcement policies and procedures. It will take at least 18 months to become fully functional again.
