Release Warns Against Illegal Gaming Events

A news release issued jointly by the Gaming Commission and the Colorado Attorney General's Office on Aug. 31 warns Colorado residents against participating in illegal gambling activities.

The release provides the Commission's and the Attorney General's joint position on the legalities of internet gaming, telephone sports books, poker tournaments outside casinos and social gambling. The release can be viewed online on the News & Information page on the Division of Gaming web site.

Commission Action

August Revenues Cool Down

Revenues at Colorado casinos cooled off in August after a record high in July. Casinos statewide reported \$63.8 million in AGP in August, down more than 8.7 percent from an all-time high of \$69.9 million in July, but up nearly 2.1 percent from \$62.5 million in August 2004. Black Hawk's 21 casinos produced nearly \$43.7 million in AGP in August; Cripple Creek's 19 casinos, more than \$13.9 million; and Central City's six casinos, \$6.1 million. Casinos paid nearly \$5.2 million in gaming taxes in August, with 29 casinos at the 0.25 percent level, seven at 2 percent, one at 4 percent, six at 11 percent and three at the upper 16 percent or 20 percent levels.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

I have mentioned the Central City Parkway numerous times in the past year for a reason. The Parkway has revitalized the Central City casino market because of one vital commodity in the history of gaming in Colorado—access. In fact, before it was officially named, the road was commonly referred to as the Southern Access Road.



The value of access has been evident since day one of Colorado gaming. In the early days, Highway 67 leading into Cripple Creek featured a one-lane tunnel that caused access problems, especially when the tunnel was forced to close and a two-lane bypass was quickly carved in the hill around it. You have to know where to look to see the old tunnel, but it is still there as a reminder of how gaming has changed the roads leading to the three gaming communities.

The industry is also reminded of the value of access every time a winter storm—or even the forecast of a storm—hits the gaming areas. Almost every little dip in revenues during winter months can be attributable to a snow or ice event, especially if the bad weather falls on a weekend.

Access has also impacted the industry this summer. Highway 6 through Clear Creek Canyon was closed June 21 because of a rock slide. At first, the Colorado Dept. of Transportation thought the road would reopen a few weeks later. Because the hillside turned out to be more unstable than anticipated, the highway ended up being closed until Sept. 19, almost three months after it closed. Although July's record high numbers didn't reflect the impact of the highway's closing since July had five weekends, the August numbers told the tale. Revenues in Black Hawk, which is directly accessed by Highway 6, were down 1.25 percent over the previous year. Although revenues in Central City were up 27.72 percent over August 2004, they were not near the 57.81 percent annual growth earned in July, largely due to another access problem encountered in August, a rock slide along Interstate 70 near Idaho Springs that backed traffic up past the Central City Parkway exit.

When analyzing historical trends in casino gaming revenues in Colorado, one of the first variables you must consider is access. It has been that way since the beginning and will continue as long as people have to drive to the mountains.
