Hearings Condensed

The Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission's annual gaming tax-setting hearing process will conclude in May rather than June, following a condensed two-month schedule rather than three months.

The process will commence April 20 with a presentation on methodology and testimony from the state agencies impacted by gaming that normally would provide information in May. The hearings in May will combine testimony from the local and county governments impacted by gaming and from the Division, the industry and the Commission's independent CPA regarding the financial state of the industry.

Should the Commission need additional time and information to reach a decision, the process may be continued until the June meeting. However, a decision is anticipated at the May meeting, which has been moved to Tuesday, May 30, rather than the customary third Thursday of the month.

Commission Action

At its regular meeting on Feb. 16 in Lakewood, the Gaming Commission:

• Renewed the retail licenses of Bullwhackers Casino, Silver Hawk Casino and Bullpen Sports Casino

•Issued new operator license to Atronic Americas LLC

•Issued Order to Show Cause to The Eureka Ltd.!

•Approved Stipulation and Agreement between Division and The Virgin Mule, resulting in oneday closure of casino

Revenues Short in February

Revenues at Colorado casinos fell short in February. Casinos statewide generated \$61.5 million in AGP in February, down 3.7 percent from \$63.9 million in January and down 0.9 percent from \$62.0 million in February 2005.

Black Hawk's 21 casinos produced \$43.9 million in AGP in February, down from \$45.7 million in January and even with the same amount in February 2005. Cripple Creek's 19 casinos totaled \$12.0 million in AGP in February, down slightly from \$12.2 million in January and \$12.1 million the previous year. Central City's six casinos reported nearly \$5.5 million in AGP in February, down from nearly \$5.9 million the previous month and \$6.0 million in February 2005.

Casinos statewide paid \$10.1 million in gaming taxes in February, down from \$10.3 million in January.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

One of my early goals as director of the Division of Gaming has been to improve efficiencies. This is a goal shared by the Gaming Commission. When the Commission asked me in February to look at condensing the tax-setting process into two months instead of three, I knew Division staff would be up to the

challenge. Our primary concern was to ensure all the participants in the process would have ample opportunity to receive and provide the information they needed. The industry has always relied upon the financial statement information provided by the Division and the Commission's independent CPA firm that reviews and analyzes that information. We met with the CPA firm to ensure they could perform their work in time for the May meeting, which has been moved to May 30 to accommodate commissioners' schedules and to provide more time for the financial statement evaluation process. They assured us that they could. We then contacted the Colorado Gaming Association to determine if the industry was comfortable with the new schedule. They were amenable.

The industry's request last year to move the testimony of local and county governments from May to June actually helped facilitate this year's schedule. The May meeting will be a repeat of last year's June meeting, combining local government testimony with presentations on the financial viability of the industry. The April meeting also has a natural progression. April has traditionally been reserved for testimony on methodology, which normally did not take a large amount of time. This year it will be augmented by presentations by state agencies impacted by gaming, including the Department of Local Affairs representing the Local Government Limited Gaming Impact Advisory Committee. Local Affairs will also be presenting its budget request at the April meeting, so its tax hearing testimony on the same day saves time for Local Affairs staff.

In the end, the reduced schedule will save time for everyone involved without sacrificing the integrity of the process. That's what efficiency is all about.
