FY07 Budgets OK'd

The Gaming Commission on April 20 approved budget requests for FY 2007 for the Division of Gaming, \$7,522,188; the Colorado Bureau of Investigations, \$797,943; Colorado State Patrol, \$1,594,960; the Division of Fire Safety, \$164,005; and Dept. of Local Affairs, \$131,140.

Commission Action

At its regular meeting on April 20 in Lakewood, the Commission:

• Renewed the retail licenses of Bronco Billy's Sports Bar & Casino; Buffalo Billy's Casino; Fortune Valley Hotel and Casino; The Lodge Casino at Black Hawk; The Gilpin Hotel Casino, Ltd.; Red Dolly Casino; Virgin Mule Casino; The Wild Card Saloon; and Black Hawk Station

• Renewed the operator licenses of Fortune Valley Hotel and Casino, The Lodge Casino at Black Hawk, and Atlantic City Coin & Slot Service Company, Inc.

•Renewed the manufacturer/ distributor license of Atlantic City Coin & Slot Service Company, Inc.

 Issued new retail licenses to CC Tollgate, LLC, dba Century Casino, and Riley and Associates, Inc., dba O'Riley's Poker Parlor

• Issued new operator license to Century Casinos Management Inc.

Casino Revenues March Forth

Revenues at Colorado casinos sprang back in March after a dismal February. Casinos statewide reported \$66.5 million in AGP in March, up 8.2 percent from \$61.5 million in February and up 4.0 percent from \$64.0 million in March 2005. Black Hawk's 21 casinos totaled \$47.7 million in AGP in March, up from \$43.9 million in February and \$45.7 million in March 2005. Cripple Creek's 19 casinos produced nearly \$12.9 million in AGP in March, an increase from \$12.0 million in February and \$11.8 million the previous year. Central City's six casinos generated \$5.9 million in AGP in March, up from nearly \$5.5 million the previous month, but down from \$6.4 million in March 2005. Casinos statewide paid \$11.2 million in gaming taxes in March, compared to \$10.1 million in February.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Since late last year, the Division of Gaming and the Division of Tax Auditing and Compliance (TAC) have been studying the feasibility of having TAC conduct revenue audits as part of its overall audit program, which includes sales taxes, wage withholding taxes and other taxes collected by the Department



of Revenue from casinos. Those efforts came to fruition in early April when I sent a letter to casinos informing them that TAC would be performing "onestop-shopping" casino revenue audits, that include gaming taxes along with the other taxes collected by the Department. As part of this move, two FTE have been assigned from the Division audit section to TAC. For the duration of this agreement, the remaining audit staff will focus attention on systems audits and compliance reviews. The Division has always maintained these two areas are the first line of defense in tax and regulatory compliance matters. In most cases, if a casino has solid systems on which they can rely and effective internal control measures in place, fewer, if any, tax-related problems will exist. By ensuring these foundational processes are in place through an emphasis on systems and compliance reviews, the Division believes tax problems will be minimized.

The movement of tax audits to TAC is a major change for the Division, but not the only change taking place. The Division has redesigned support and key license employee badges to remove the employee's name from the front of the badge. I believe that the license number serves as a more effective identifier of a licensee and that nicknames, although clever in some cases, do not serve a purpose on identification for a privileged state-issued license.

The Division also has added a new release form to the new and renewal support applications that requires the signatures of both the applicant and their spouse. We realize this may present problems for applicants, especially walkin applicants, but this form is necessary to continue accessing and reporting state tax information. With the help of casinos, we hope to let potential applicants know about this new requirement before they walk into a Division office, so they can obtain the necessary signatures beforehand.
