Imhoff Reappointed

Gov. Bill Owens has appointed Gaming Commissioner Patty Imhoff to a full four-year term as the Commission's business member. Imhoff was originally appointed to the Commission in January to finish out the term of former **Commission Chair Natalie Meyer** that expired June 30.

Hourly Rate Increased

The Gaming Commission on June 15 approved a \$63 per hour rate for background investigations for fiscal year 2007, up from \$59 per hour the current fiscal year. The fiscal year 2007 license fee for new support applications remains at \$100; new key application, \$250; renewal support application, \$60; and key renewals, \$200.

Commission Action

At its regular meeting on June 15 in Lakewood, the Gaming Commission:

• Renewed the retail licenses of Brass Ass Casino, J.P. McGill's Hotel & Casino, Midnight Rose Hotel & Casino, Gold Creek Casino, Double Eagle Hotel & Casino, Creeker's Casino, Colorado Grande Casino, Womacks Casino, Legends Casino, and Richman Casino

• Renewed the operator license of Colorado Casino Resorts, Inc.

• Approved change of ownership for Fortune Valley Hotel & Casino and PDS Gaming Corporation-Colorado

• Approved proposed changes to Rule 10, amending the rules of play for Boston 5 Stud Poker

Revenues in May Fall Slightly

Revenues at Colorado casinos fell slightly in May. Gaming establishments statewide reported \$65.6 million in AGP in May, down from \$65.8 million in April and \$66.2 million in May 2005.

Black Hawk's 21 casinos recorded \$47.1 million in AGP in May, down from \$47.9 million in April, but up from \$46.6 million in May 2005. Cripple Creek's 19 casinos totaled \$12.9 million in AGP in May, up from \$12.3 million in April and even with the same amount produced the previous year. Central City's six casinos generated \$5.5 million in AGP in May, even with the previous month, but down from \$6.6 million in May 2005.

Casinos statewide paid \$11.2 million in gaming taxes in May, with six casinos reporting revenues in the 0.25 percent bracket, nine at 2 percent, eight at 4 percent, seven at 11 percent, four at 16 percent and 12 at the top 20 percent level.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

For the past few months I have been emphasizing changes taking place at the Division and with the Commission. A key ingredient to any type of change is flexibility. Even the best made plans are subject to change.



A perfect example of this is the transfer of the tax revenue

auditing process to the Colorado Division of Tax Auditing and Compliance (TAC) that I wrote about two months ago. The concept behind the move was sound-tap into the expertise of a group of tax examiners who could perform "one-stop-shopping" by combining the gaming tax revenue audit with the other tax audits performed by the department. However, the logistics of the administrative accounting of time and resources between two divisions proved to be too big of a hurdle to overcome. The cost simply outweighed the benefit.

The entire effort, however, was not in vain. In going through the process of exploring how best to conduct the three components of the Division's audit process-compliance reviews, system audits and revenue audits-we discovered new ways to streamline the process without sacrificing the integrity of our audits.

The result is even more change. We discovered that the systems audit process, which has taken on a life of its own over the past few years, was larger than the two systems specialists the Division employed in our emerging technologies section could ever be expected to handle. As a result, the Division has created a five-member systems team to conduct system audits. That team will report to Brenda Davis, the Division's director of administration, until its duties and processes can be refined. Once that takes place, the unit will become part of the Audit Section.

The Division is also looking to tackle the recruitment and retention problem in the Audit Section caused by the commute to the Black Hawk/Central City area by locating more auditors out of the Lakewood office.

These changes, of course, are subject to change. We will keep you posted. —Ron Kammerzell
