#### Up and Down Month for AGP in November

Revenues at Colorado casinos in November were more up than down. Gaming establishments statewide reported \$63.1 million in AGP in November, down nearly 2.6 percent from \$64.7 million in AGP in October, but up 5.9 percent from \$59.6 million in November 2005.

Black Hawk's 21 casinos totaled nearly \$44.7 million in AGP in November, down from \$45.5 million in October, but up from \$42.8 million in November 2005. Cripple Creek's 19 casinos generated \$12.1 million in AGP in November, down from \$12.2 million in October, but up from \$11.2 million the previous November. Central City's six casinos produced \$6.2 million in AGP in November, down from \$7.0 million the previous month, but up from \$5.5 million in November 2005.

Casinos statewide paid \$9.3 million in gaming taxes in November.

### Looking Back at the Year 2006

• January—Gov. William Owens announced the appointments of William Hybl, Patty Imhoff and Meyer Saltzman to the Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission to replace Natalie Meyer, Rob Millman and Barbara Jenkins.

• January-Ron Kammerzell, the security director for the Colorado Lottery and 13-year veteran of the Division of Gaming, was named Division of Gaming director, replacing Mark Wilson, who accepted another position within the Colorado Department of Revenue.

 March—The Gaming Commission approved proposed changes to Gaming Rule 12, which changed the burden of inspecting and approving gaming devices prior to the devices being placed on the gaming floor from the Division of Gaming to casino operators. The changes went into effect May 30.

• April—The Gaming Commission commenced a condensed two-month tax setting process that concluded on May 30 with the Commission retaining the existing tax structure.

• June—Gov. William Owens re-appointed Commissioner Patty Imhoff to a fouryear term on the Commission.

•June—Phil Dinan, agent-in-charge of the Division's Central City and Black Hawk office, retired after nearly 13 years of service to the Division. He was replaced by Lad Sullivan, a supervisory investigator in the Cripple Creek office.

• July-The Southern Ute Indian Tribe announced their plans to build a new casino north of Ignacio to open in the spring of 2008.

• July—Casinos paid a record \$106.1 million in gaming taxes in fiscal year 2006.

•August—Commissioner William Hybl announced his resignation from the Commission due to scheduling conflicts.

• August—The annual distribution of the Limited Gaming Fund topped the \$100 million mark for the first time.

• August—Casinos reported a record monthly high for gaming revenues, earning \$74.2 million in AGP in July, the first time revenues exceeded \$70 million in a month.

• September—A Central City casino and its operator were fined a total of \$87,500 for placing five machines on the casino floor that were not approved for play in Colorado because they had a "double down" feature that potentially violated the state's \$5 constitutional maximum wager restriction. Two other casinos were fined for offering slot machines with revoked software, one month after four other casinos were fined for similar violations.

• October—The Commission approved a rulemaking petition to allow ATM functionality to be housed with a ticket redemption kiosk. A rulemaking hearing on the matter is scheduled for Jan. 18, 2007.

 November—A Central City casino was fined \$100,000 and ordered to close for one day for training for failing to be able to account for revenues during its first three months of operation. A Cripple Creek casino was issued an order to show cause for 22 alleged gaming violations, while nine casinos were fined for offering slot machines with revoked software.

• December-The Colorado State Patrol indicated to the Commission that it planned to ask for four additional FTE to patrol gaming highways in FY2008.
