Revenues Continue **Double-Digit Slide**

Colorado casino revenues fell by 14.5 percent in October compared to the same month in 2007. Gaming establishments statewide reported \$56.3 million in AGP in October, down 5.1 percent from \$59.3 million in September and down 14.5 percent from \$65.8 million in October 2007. For the year, casinos revenues are down 11.7 percent from the first 10 months of 2007.

Commission Approves 13 New Division FTE

The Gaming Commission on Nov. 20 approved a supplemental budget request of \$602,055 for the Division of Gaming to implement Amendment 50. The request includes the addition of 13 employees, consisting of two auditors, two compliance investigators, two background investigators, and seven criminal investigators starting Feb. 1, 2009.

Commission Action

At its meeting on Nov. 20 meeting, the Gaming Commission:

- Renewed the retail licenses of Ameristar Casino Black Hawk, Canyon Casino and Grand Plateau Casino
- Renewed the operator licenses of Ameristar Casino Black Hawk and Universal Gaming Resources LLC
- Renewed the manufacturer/distributor licenses of American Gaming & Electronics, Inc.; Ameristar Casino Black Hawk, Inc.; and Universal Gaming Resources LLC

Voters Pass Amendment 50

Colorado voters on Nov. 4 approved Amendment 50, giving the electorate in Black Hawk, Central City and Cripple Creek the option to approve raising the maximum wager limit up to \$100, add the games of craps and/or roulette, and allow 24-hour gaming after July 1, 2009.

Voters in those towns can approve all or a portion of those options for their communities. Cripple Creek is scheduled to vote on Dec. 16, while Black Hawk voters will go to the polls Jan. 13. Central City is anticipated to hold its election in February or March.

The amendment earmarks additional State revenues generated by the changes to community colleges and to the gaming towns and counties. It also requires voter approval for any increase in gaming tax rates. The Colorado legislature must enact legislation during its next session starting in January to facilitate and clarify the new changes allowed in the new amendment.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Most of the speculation is now over. Colorado voters did indeed pass Amendment 50, the first and biggest hurdle in raising limits, adding craps and roulette, and allowing 24-hour gaming. "Limited" gaming in Colorado will become less limited after July 1. The next step in the process is local voter approval, which is likely to be more of a formality than it is an undetermined outcome.



After that, the ball falls into the laps of the Commission, the Division and the Legislature to interpret, codify and implement the provisions of the amendment. We took the first step in that process by taking a request to the Commission at its Nov. 20 meeting for an additional \$602,055 this fiscal year to fund 13 new employees, the training of existing staff on craps and roulette, and the reconfiguration of our offices to accommodate the new employees.

The Division has also already started the process of drafting rules and internal controls for craps and roulette, and reviewing existing rules and internal controls to determine if any changes need to be made as the result of the higher limits and extended hours. Fortunately there is a wealth of experience to draw upon from other jurisdictions that consider craps and roulette old hat. Still, learning craps especially is not an overnight process.

In the infancy of Amendment 50, the biggest challenge that we grapple with is not so much the implementation of the new games, limits and hours, but with the interpretation of who gets how much money under the language of the amendment. That's something that we hope that the Legislature can hash out and make it easy to interpret and administer. If not, the Commission will be faced with a big policy decision that will have the interest of all the current recipients of the Limited Gaming Fund and the new.

For many the excitement of the elections is over. For us, it has just begun.
