Commission Passes Amendment 50 Rules

The Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission approved proposed changes to Colorado Limited Gaming Regulations related to the implementation of Amendment 50 at its March 19 meeting. The Commission gave approval to changes primarily related to the addition of references to craps and roulettes throughout the existing rules and the changing of references to the \$5 maximum wager to the new \$100 maximum bet.

The Commission also passed new rules for the games of craps and roulette.

The rule changes will be effective on July 2. Copies of the approved changes can be viewed on the Division's web site on the Rulemaking Hearings page under the Commission Section.

Commission Action

At its meeting on March 19 in Lakewood, the Colorado Gaming Commission:

• Renewed the retail licenses of Billy's Casino, Bronco Billy's Sports Bar & Casino, Buffalo Billy's Casino, Bullpen Casino, Bullwhackers Casino, Century Casino, Legends Casino and Womack's Casino

• Renewed the manufacturer/distributor license of Penn Bullwhackers, Inc.

• Renewed the operator license of Century Casinos Management, Inc.

• Approved a new manufacturer/ distributor license for Paltronics, Inc.

February AGP Comes Up Short

Colorado casino revenues fell short in February because of a shortage of days. Casinos statewide reported \$57.3 million in AGP in February, down 1.1 percent from \$57.9 million in February 2008 and down 0.5 percent from \$57.5 million in January. The slight decrease in revenues from the previous year is attributable to the fact that February 2008 had 29 days.

Black Hawk's 20 casinos totaled \$41.2 million in AGP in February, down slightly from \$41.9 million in February 2008 and \$41.5 million in January. Cripple Creek's 16 casinos generated \$11.0 million in AGP in February, up 4.2 percent from \$10.6 million the previous February and up 3.0 percent from \$10.7 million in January. Central City's six casinos produced \$5.0 million in AGP in February, down from \$5.4 million in January 2008 and \$5.2 million the previous month.

Casinos statewide paid \$9.4 million in gaming tax proceeds in February, up from \$9.2 million in January.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

By July 2, you will become weary of me addressing the Division's preparations for the implementation of Amendment 50. However, a major milestone was reached on March 19 when the Commission approved changes to the existing gaming rules related to the implementation of Amendment 50, as well as the new rules for craps and roulette.



A lot of hard work and dedication from Division staff went into putting these rules together, especially the new craps and roulette rules. The Division's Table Games Committee put a lot of time and research into drafting and presenting these rules. I want to commend committee chair Hank Hasler; committee members Geri Clerkin, Sean Ballain, Jim Wattles, Brad Nelson and Chris Moore; and consulting members Deb Gorham and Kenneth Page. Brenda Davis and Laura Manning serve as management advisory members on that committee, as well. Just because the rules have been passed doesn't mean that their work is done. As I mentioned last month, the Division will be conducting internal training on these games in May as we attempt to get ahead of the learning curve prior to July 2. We realize that our learning will still need to continue after that point, as we continue to review how these rules work in the live environment.

Our work is also not done when it comes to rule changes for Amendment 50. HB 1272 contains a provision that the expenses related to the administration of Amendment 50 will be "determined in accordance with rules of the commission." Based upon the interest that the HB 1272 legislative hearings have drawn in relation to Amendment 50 revenues, we are anticipating a large turnout at the hearings on the expenses. We are tentatively planning on holding those hearings on May 21. I will keep you posted when schedules are finalized, just as I will continue to keep you updated on other Amendment 50 developments.
