Commission Approves Fiscal Year 10 Budgets

The Gaming Commission on April 16 approved budget requests for FY 2010 for the Division of Gaming, \$9,677,540; the Colorado Bureau of Investigations, \$841,515; Colorado State Patrol, \$2,152,086; the Division of Fire Safety, \$186,931; and Dept. of Local Affairs, \$158,094.

May Schedule Altered

The Gaming Commission will hold its regular meeting on Wednesday, May 20 at the Division of Gaming office in Lakewood starting at 9:15 a.m. The Commission will hold a special meeting on Thursday, May 21 for a rulemaking hearing on proposed new Rule 24. That meeting will be held at the Jefferson County Courts Administration Building, 100 Jefferson Parkway, Golden, starting at 9:30 a.m.

Commission Action

At its meeting on April 16 in Lakewood, the Colorado Gaming Commission:

- Renewed the retail licenses of Black Hawk Station; The Gilpin Hotel Casino, Ltd.; The Lodge Casino at Black Hawk; The Wild Card Saloon; and Wildwood Casino at Cripple Creek
- Renewed the manufacturer/distributor licenses of Atlantic City Coin & Slot Service Company, Inc.; and The Lodge Casino at Black
- Renewed the operator licenses of Atlantic City Coin & Slot Service Company, Inc., and Merit Cripple Creek, LLC

March Revenues Hot and Cold

Revenues at Colorado casinos in March cooled off compared to March 2008, but heated up from February. Casinos statewide reported \$60.6 million in AGP in March, down 4.1 percent from \$63.2 million in March 2008, but up 5.8 percent from \$57.2 million in February.

Black Hawk's 20 casinos produced \$43.6 million in AGP in March, down 4.7 percent from \$45.8 million in March 2008, but up 6.0 percent from \$41.1 million in February. Cripple Creek's 16 casinos totaled \$11.6 million in AGP in March, up 1.7 percent from \$11.4 million the previous March and up 5.4 percent from \$11.0 million in February. Central City's six casinos generated \$5.3 million in AGP in March, down 10.6 percent from \$5.9 million in March 2008, but up 4.9 percent from \$5.0 million the previous month.

Casinos statewide paid \$10.2 million in gaming tax proceeds in March, up from \$9.4 million in February.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

As the Colorado legislative session comes to a close on May 6, we are closer to knowing the status of several bills affecting the casino industry in Colorado.

The most noted is House Bill 1272, the enabling legislation for the implementation of Amendment 50. This bill was sent to the governor on April 14 after passing both the House and the



Senate. As mentioned last month, this legislation contains a provision that the expenses related to the administration of Amendment 50 will be "determined in accordance with rules of the commission." A hearing on those proposed rules is scheduled for May 21 at the Jefferson County Courts & Administration Building in Golden. As noted in the article on this page, the regular Commission meeting for May will be held on May 20 to accommodate this hearing.

Senate Bill 50 was also sent to the governor on April 14. This bill would require that the citizen member on the Gaming Commission be a resident of Gilpin or Teller counties. We believe this is not sound public policy because of perceived conflict of interest possibilities. Not that it would occur, but the drafters of the original Limited Gaming Act in 1991 were cognizant of this when prohibiting Commissioners from having an interest in property in those two counties. The old adage "if it ain't broke, don't fix it" should apply here, but the Legislature saw differently. We hope the governor agrees with our position, but we will wait to see.

House Bill 1137 is still making its way through the legislative process. This bill would include criminal court restitutions to the Gambling Payment Intercept Act and add an \$85 fee to the amount intercepted.

If and when any or all of these bills become law, the Commission and Division will fulfill their statutory responsibilities to implement them and enforce them.
