OCTOBER 1, 1993

On September 30, 1993, the Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission voted to reduce the state gaming device fee from \$150 to \$100 for the gaming year beginning today. This fee applies to any slot machine, poker and black jack table in use at anytime during the gaming year.

The Commission also made the device fee payable in a single payment rather than in two installments as last year.

The Commission is allowing casinos until October 20, 1993, to purchase the device stamps. This grace period does not eliminate the casino's responsibility to pay for all devices in use as of October 1, 1993. In other words, if a casino has a device in use at any time on or after October 1 but takes that device out of service prior to purchasing device stamps, the casino must pay a device fee for that device anyway.

If you have not already done so, please contact your local Division of Gaming office to schedule an appointment to pay the device fees before October 20.

Casinos utilizing a gaming device without purchasing a state device stamp are in violation of state gaming rules and regulations and may be subject to sanctions.
