

# STATEMENT OF GAMING REVENUES GAMING TAXES, AND EXPENDITURES (UNAUDITED) FOR THE TEN (10) MONTHS ENDED APRIL 30, 2007

#### COLORADO DIVISION OF GAMING TAX REVENUES COMPARISON APRIL 30, 2007 AND 2006

The Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission assesses taxes based on adjusted gross proceeds.

The tax rates for period ending June 30, 2007 are:
.25% on amounts up to \$2 million
2% on amounts over \$2 million and up to \$4 million
4% on amounts over \$4 million and up to \$5 million
11% on amounts over \$5 million and up to \$10 million
16% on amounts over \$10 million and up to \$15 million
20% on amounts over \$15 million

The tax rates for year ending June 30, 2006 were the same as they are for year ending June 30, 2007.
