

Colorado Restaurant Sales 2003 Third Quarter




This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the third quarter 2003. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premise consumption.

The data show that Colorado restaurant industry sales in the third quarter 2003 decreased 2.5 percent, to about \$1.53 billion, over third quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 7.9 percent, to \$411.2 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, Larimer County experienced the largest decrease at -6.4 percent. Of the counties reviewed, Douglas County showed the largest increase over last year at 5.6 percent.
