


This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the third quarter 2005. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premise consumption.

The data show that Colorado restaurant industry sales in the third quarter 2005 increased 4.9 percent, to about \$1.74 billion, over third quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 6.8 percent, to \$116.7 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, Douglas County experienced the largest increase at 7.5 percent. Only Broomfield County showed a decrease (-4.0 percent) over last year.
