


This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the second quarter 2007. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premises consumption.

The data show that Colorado restaurant industry sales in the second quarter 2007 increased 8.2 percent, to about \$1.97 billion, over second quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 6.0 percent, to \$114.5 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, all the counties studied showed positive increases over last year. Adams County and Denver County experienced double-digit increases. The reader should note the source of the national figures has been changed to unadjusted Census Bureau retail sales.
