
Colorado Restaurant Sales Selected Counties

Fourth Quarter 2007


This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the fourth quarter 2007. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premises consumption.

The data show that Colorado restaurant industry sales in the fourth quarter 2007 increased 10.1 percent, to about \$1.96 billion, over fourth quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 4.8 percent, to \$114.6 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, all the counties studied showed positive increases over last year. The reader should note the source of the national figures has been changed to unadjusted Census Bureau retail sales.
