


This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the first quarter 2008. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premises consumption.

The data show that Colorado restaurant industry sales in the first quarter 2008 increased 5.5 percent, to about \$2.06 billion, over first quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 4.7 percent, to \$109.1 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, Adams County showed the largest increase at 15.2 percent. The reader should note the source of the national figures has been changed to unadjusted Census Bureau retail sales.
