



This issue presents data on third quarter 2004 motor vehicle retail sales for each of the seven Denver metro counties and the counties of El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, Weld, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, and Mesa. Broomfield County's sales are combined with those in Boulder County. In addition, the graph below compares sales of new and used cars and trucks for the United States as a whole to total sales of the counties listed above for the same period.

Sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed increased 8.3 percent to \$2.79 billion in third quarter 2004 compared to second quarter 2004. The data also show that sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed decreased 1.7 percent in third quarter 2004 over third quarter 2003. Nationally, sales of motor vehicles increased 0.4 percent over last year to about \$386.4 billion. As shown on the next page, La Plata County posted the largest increase at 17.7 percent. Garfield County posted the largest decrease at -8.7 percent compared to last year.
