



This issue presents data on fourth quarter 2005 motor vehicle retail sales for each of the seven Denver metro counties and the counties of El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, Weld, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, and Mesa. Broomfield County's sales are combined with those in Boulder County. In addition, the graph below compares sales of new and used cars and trucks for the United States as a whole to total sales of the counties listed above for the same period.

Sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed decreased 20.0 percent to \$2.3 billion in fourth quarter 2005 compared to third quarter 2005. The data also show that sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed decreased 13.6 percent in fourth quarter 2005 over fourth quarter 2004. Nationally, sales of motor vehicles decreased 11.9 percent over last year to about \$83.7 billion. As shown on the next page, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, and Mesa counties posted small increases. Douglas County posted the largest decrease at -20.3 percent compared to last year.
