
Colorado Motor Vehicle Sales

Selected Counties


Fourth Quarter 2007

This issue presents data on fourth quarter 2007 motor vehicle retail sales for each of the seven Denver metro counties and the counties of El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, Weld, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, and Mesa. Broomfield County's sales are combined with those in Boulder County. In addition, the graph below compares sales of new and used cars and trucks for the United States as a whole to total sales of the counties listed above for the same period.

Sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed decreased 8.7 percent to \$2.5 billion in fourth quarter 2007 compared to third quarter 2007. The data also show that sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed increased 8.4 percent in fourth quarter 2007 over fourth quarter 2006. Nationally, sales of motor vehicles increased 2.0 percent over last year to about \$182.5 billion. As shown on the next page, Douglas County saw the largest increase at 19.8 percent. The data did not show any decrease in motor sales, however Arapahoe County experienced the smallest increase of 1.8 percent compared to last year. The reader should note the source of the national figures has been changed to unadjusted Census Bureau retail sales.
