
Colorado Motor Vehicle Sales

Selected Counties


Second Quarter 2008

This issue presents data on second quarter 2008 motor vehicle retail sales for each of the seven Denver metro counties and the counties of El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, Weld, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, and Mesa. Broomfield County's sales are combined with those in Boulder County. In addition, the graph below compares sales of new and used cars and trucks for the United States as a whole to total sales of the counties listed above for the same period.

Sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed decreased 10.9 percent to \$2.4 billion in second quarter 2008 compared to second quarter 2007. The data also show that sales of motor vehicles in the counties studied increased 0.9 percent in second quarter 2008 over first quarter 2008. Nationally, sales of motor vehicles decreased 10.0 percent over last year to about \$181.5 billion. As shown on the next page, Pueblo County experienced the largest percentage decrease at 21.3 percent. However, seven other counties showed double-digit decreases over last year. The reader should note the source of the national figures has been changed to unadjusted Census Bureau retail sales.
