
Colorado Motor Vehicle Sales

Selected Counties


First Quarter 2010

This issue presents data on first quarter 2010 motor vehicle retail sales for each of the seven Denver metro counties and the counties of El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, Weld, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, and Mesa. In addition, the graph below compares sales of new and used cars and trucks for the United States as a whole to total sales of the counties listed above for the same period.

Although sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed decreased 2.0 percent to \$1.8 billion in first quarter 2010 compared to fourth quarter 2009, the data show that sales of motor vehicles in the counties reviewed increased 8.4 percent in first quarter 2010 over first quarter 2009. Nationally, sales of motor vehicles increased in a similar 8.9 percent over the same period last year to about \$143.1 billion. Douglas, LaPlata, and Mesa counties showed decreases over the same period last year.
