## Colorado Building Material Sales Selected Counties

## Third Quarter 2009

This issue presents data on Colorado building materials sales for the third quarter 2009. This report shows retail sales for each of the seven Denver metro area counties and for the counties of El Paso, Fremont, Garfield, La Plata, Larimer, Mesa, Pueblo, and Weld. Broomfield County's sales are combined with those in Boulder County. The types of retailers included in the chart on the next page are home centers, paint and wallcovering stores, hardware stores, and specialized building material dealers. The period shown in this report is the third quarter of 2009 compared to the third quarter of 2008.

The graph below shows national versus Colorado retail sales. It is important to note that both the national and Colorado data in this graph include sales by outdoor equipment stores and nurseries as well as the categories listed in the above paragraph. Nationally, sales of building materials decreased 14.0 percent to $\$ 72.9$ billion in the third quarter 2009 over the third quarter 2008. Colorado's retail sales of building materials excluding nurseries were $\$ 1.085 .9$ million in third quarter 2009, 18.2 percent below the same quarter from a year ago. The reader should also note the source of the national figures has been changed to unadjusted Census Bureau retail sales.

Sales in the counties comprising this report decreased 15.5 percent over last year. All 14 counties studied showed decreases over last year. Garfield and Mesa counties showed a decrease in sales over 30.0 percent.
