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
Active Occupational Licenses




2016 vs 2017 Monthly Average


• On average, there were an additional 139,605 plants cultivated per month during the first six months of 2017 compared to the first six months of 2016.

Plants by County

• Denver County's share of the total plants in the state decreased from 62% in January, 2017 to 55% in June, 2017. This is likely a result of the seasonal cultivation patterns in some parts of the state.



Volume Sold to Consumers


Flower Sales

• Medical sales accounted for 44% of the total volume of flower sold to consumers during the first six months of 2017. In the first six months of 2016, medical sales accounted for 52% of the total volume of flower sold.

Edible and Non-Edible Sales

• Medical sales accounted for 25% of the total units of edibles and 20% of the total units of non-edibles sold to consumers in 2017. In the first six months of 2016, those percentages were 32% and 31% respectively.





- 34,817 individual packages of retail marijuana were submitted for contaminant testing during the first six months of 2017.
