

Highlights 2003

- To kick off 2003, the Lottery introduced a \$10 Scratch ticket, 20 YEAR ADVENTURE, in celebration of the Colorado Lottery's 20th anniversary. 20 YEAR ADVENTURE was the result of a graphic design contest open to the public. Janice Green of Parker combined Lottery proceeds (which fund parks and recreation in Colorado) and the excitement of Scratch games in her winning concept.
- To offer more variety to players, the Colorado Lottery increased the number of Scratch games at some retail locations from 12 games to 16. Scratch games range in price from \$1 to \$10.
- The Colorado Lottery introduced a new ticket delivery system in 2003. Uşing a courier service allows retailers to plan for the introduction of new games, and arrange inventory accordingly.
- Department of Revenue Director M. Michael Cook announced the hiring of new Lottery Director Peggy Gordon. Gordon replaced long time Lottery Director Mark Zamarripa who retired in November 2003.
- * The Lottery made its way across the state from Olathe to Greeley with the "Summer of Bingo." The \$3 Bingo Scratch game promotions included event sponsorships that allowed the Lottery to educate players about Bingo.
- # Again in 2003, the Lottery offered players the opportunity to Catch the Lotto Bug. The Lottery awarded four Volkswagen Beetles to players from around the state.
- The Colorado Lottery won three Batchy Awards for advertising in 2003. Batchy awards are given by the North American Association of State and Provincial Lotteries for outstanding advertising in the lottery industry. The Colorado Lottery won awards for Best Cinematography, Best Coordinated Campaign for Print, and Best Corporate Radio Advertising. The Lottery was also a finalist for Best Original Music and Best Lotto TV/Radio.



- The Colorado Lottery instituted its Prize Patrol program as a fun way to notify second-chance grand prize winners. Various Scratch games in 2003 included second-chance drawings, featuring prizes ranging from \$25,000 to \$250,000.
- Starburst Awards were presented to a dozen parks and recreation projects in 2003. The Starburst program recognizes excellence in the use of Lottery proceeds. The top winners in 2003 were the City of Pueblo for their City Park Playground, the Town of Lyons for the Lyons Whitewater Park, the City of Lakewood for the Charles Whitlock Recreation Center In-Line Hockey Rink, and the City of Fort Morgan for the Municipal Swimming Pool Renovation.
- The Colorado Lottery brought the live Powerball drawing to Colorado in 2003. The drawing, which is typically conducted in Des Moines, lowa, was held live from FOX31 Studios in Denver.


A Glance at 2004

The Colorado Lottery will undergo a major computer conversion in 2004, most of which will be invisible to Colorado Lottery players. Once the conversion is complete, players will see new, more convenient Scratch ticket vending machines, and self ticket checkers.



- The Lottery will let the dogs out in 2004 with a new Lucky Dog Scratch ticket to be introduced in May. Dogs from around the state were invited in 2003 to compete for a chance to appear on the tickets. The promotion also involved an Internet component in which visitors to www.coloradolottery.com had a chance to vote for their favorite dog. In the end, eight dogs were selected to appear on the tickets.
- The Lottery will continue to explore ways to make the web site more informative, convenient, entertaining, and marketing-orientated.
- The Lottery will introduce the first ticket benefiting non-profits, Win Win Cash, in 2004. This ticket features a second-chance drawing where players can win money for themselves and their favorite charity.

{September 1, 1983}

The Lottery makes its first proceeds distribution, \$41.7 million to the three designated fund recipients.

{March 5,1992}

The Lottery awards the largest Lotto jackpot in Colorado history. Kim Walker, of Boulder, wins \$27 million; she also becomes the 100th Lotto millionaire.

The Colorado Lottery surpasses the \$1 billion mark in proceeds returned to the state.

{ September 2000}

The Lottery receives two prestigious public relations awards for its Corporate Responsibility Campaign focusing on playing responsibly. The awards were given at the annual Gold Pick Awards ceremony in Denver, sponsored by the Colorado Chapter of the Public Relations Society of America.

{ November 7, 2000 }

Colorado voters approve Referendum E, allowing the Colorado Lottery to participate in multi-state lottery games. Multi-state games are products offered by more than one state, which combine their prize pools to create more attractive jackpot amounts. After extensive research, the Lottery determined Powerball was the best alternative for the Colorado Lottery, players and proceeds recipients.

{1982}

The General Assembly approves a bill implementing a state-supervised lottery. The bill created the Colorado Lottery as a division of the Department of Revenue, with a director appointed by the Executive Director of the Department of Revenue.

{ January 24, 1983}

The Colorado Lottery opens for business with gala kick-off celebrations in Pueblo, Denver, Fort Collins and Grand Junction.

Looking Back

{January 24, 1989}

The Lottery celebrates its sixth anniversary by launching Lotto.

{February 13, 1991}

The Colorado Lottery sells its one-billionth ticket.

{September 16, 1996}

The Colorado Lottery introduces a new game, Cash 5.

The Lottery introduces a new corporate slogan-"the Colorado Lottery, your ticket to a more beautiful Colorado."

{ November 2000}

The Lottery was honored with a 2000 Diversity Leaders Award from the Minority and Women's Chambers' Coalition. The distinction was presented in recognition of the Lottery's effective integration of diversity into its corporate culture, and for exhibiting inclusive behavior in all program areas.

{February 2001}

The Lottery adds two additional drawings to Cash 5 bringing the total number of drawings to six nights a week. The addition of these drawings helped push Cash 5 sales near \$17 million for fiscal year 2001.



{September 1997}

The Department of Revenue announces the first step in an effort to address gaming prevalence in Colorado. The Lottery, in conjunction with Racing and Gaming divisions, commits to addressing problem gambling in Colorado through a "play responsibly" campaign.



{ August 2, 2001 }

The Colorado Lottery introduces the mega-jackpot game Powerball. The game is introduced to players at more than 2500 retailers, with Lottery representatives participating in more than 70 promotions statewide.

December 2003}

The Department of Revenue Director announces Peggy Gordon to serve as Director of the Colorado Lottery.

Funding of Lottery Operations

The Lottery, by statute, is designated as an enterprise fund. As such, the agency receives no tax money from the state General Fund for its operations. Instead, the Lottery is self-supporting. The state Legislature approves the Lottery budget each year as part of the State Budget Bill.

Perhaps the most important feature of the Lottery's status as an enterprise fund is that the Lottery, along with the revenue it generates for its recipients, exists outside of the revenue limitations set by the Tabor Amendment (Amendment 1) approved by voters in November 1992. Because of this enterprise fund status, local and state agencies that receive Lottery proceeds can use these dollars to enhance their parks and recreation programs and facilities beyond the budget restrictions of the amendment.

Strength In Diversity

The Colorado Lottery's diversity policies embrace a spirit of openness and inclusiveness. In order to maintain a connection with the people it serves, the Lottery is involved with special events that specifically celebrate diversity, like the Denver Black Arts Festival, and various Cinco de Mayo and Pow-Wow events across the state as part of that commitment. The Lottery has served economically, ethnically and culturally diverse communities across Colorado, through the return of more than one billion dollars in proceeds. These funds have been used to create neighborhood and regional parks, recreation centers, open space and trails, and other public amenities.

It's Our Responsibility

As a state agency, the Lottery realizes its obligations to players extend beyond creating new games and generating revenue for the state. For most people, Lottery tickets are a form of entertainment, but for some, playing the Lottery can be a problem.

The Lottery implements programs and policies to address problem gambling. The Lottery has initiated a "Play Responsibly" campaign that includes point-of-sale at retail, brochures, and ticket messages urging players to play responsibly. The brochure also provides information on how to seek help for gambling-related problems.

The Lottery continues to be active in problem gambling organizations, including the Problem Gambling Coalition of Colorado, to accomplish its corporate responsibility goals.

Benefits To Business

The Lottery relies on an extensive network of retailers to sell Lottery products. Lottery retailers can be found in communities across the state, and include grocery outlets, convenience stores, and individually-owned businesses. Retailers receive a commission for every ticket they sell, which is another impact the Lottery has on local economies. In 2003, Lottery retailers, approximately 2,800 statewide, earned \$ 29.2 million.

Where the Buffalo Roam: Bison once lived across the state in Colorado, most abundant on the plains, in the mountain parks, and western basins. Today, buffalo in Colorado live only in captivity. Buffalo are the largest land animal in North America, growing up to six feet tall and weighing up to 2,200 pounds.

Winners

One of the most visible components of the Lottery is its winners. Lottery games are designed to offer a variety of different prize amounts. For example, many Lottery Scratch games have prizes that will change your day (\$50, \$100, \$1,000), while Cash 5 has a top prize that can change your year (\$20,000). Meanwhile, the Lottery's jackpot games, Powerball and Lotto, have multi-million dollar prizes that could change your life.

In 2003, prizes paid to Lottery winners totaled \$223.5 million, bringing total prizes paid since the Lottery's inception to over \$3.1 billion.

Demographics

The Lottery regularly conducts demographic studies through independent research firms. The most recent of these is an April 2003 survey conducted by the Howell Research Group. Research has shown the average Lottery player is a reflection of the average Colorado resident. (see chart on page 19)

Approval


The Colorado Lottery realizes that its corporate image and favorability are a key component to the organization's success. Therefore, a statewide image survey was conducted by the Howell Research Group in June 2003. The objective of the survey was to assess the awareness and image of the Colorado Lottery as an organization and its contribution to the state of Colorado.

Colorado residents have expressed strong support for the Colorado Lottery and the purposes for which it was established in every survey since 1991. Favorable attitudes toward the Colorado Lottery are found among all demographic segments and geographic locations. In the 2003 survey, 86 percent of those surveyed indicated they were in favor of the Colorado Lottery.

Games

{ Scratch }

Once again in 2003, the Colorado Lottery's Scratch product lead the way in sales, generating \$251.4 million during the calendar year. In 2003, the Lottery introduced a wide variety of new games ranging in price from \$1 to \$10. At any one time, players could chose from 12 to 16 different games.





A total of 39 new Scratch games were introduced in 2003. A few examples include Crossword Xtra, 7-11-21, Lucky 13, Caribbean Cash, 20 Year Adventure, Cool 5s. and Colorado Cash.

In November of 2003, the Lottery tested a new Scratch

distribution plan that utilizes courier delivery of tickets. This new method ensures that all Lottery retailers receive new games simultaneously, unlike the previous 2-week distribution method. As a result, retailers can anticipate when they will receive new games and arrange inventory accordingly, resulting in the tickets being available to all consumers in a more timely manner. In addition, Lottery sales representatives spend less time delivering new games and more time merchandising new products, and informing retailers and players about Lottery games.

In 2003, each Lottery advertising campaign combined multiple games with similar themes, extending the resources of its marketing budget. This approach-allowed several games to receive the benefits of advertising visibility with the same amount of marketing dollars previously allocated to a single game.

{ Powerball }

The introduction of Powerball in 2001 provided a boost to Colorado Lottery drawing-game sales. Powerball sales were \$78.7 million in 2003.

In addition to the high jackpots (regularly over \$100 million), funds from Powerball stay in Colorado to help parks, recreation and other environmental projects.

Powerball drawings are held on Wednesday and Saturday evenings at 8:59 pm. Players choose five numbers from a field of 53 and one number, the Powerball, from a field of 42. The jackpot, which starts at \$10 million, is awarded for matching all six numbers.

Players can also choose the PowerPlay feature for an additional \$1. PowerPlay drawings are conducted prior to the Powerball drawing, when a number between two and five is chosen. Players with the PowerPlay option that win any prize (except the jackpot) have that prize multiplied by the number drawn.

{ Lotto }

Lotto is played by selecting six numbers from a field of 42. Players who match 3, 4, 5 or 6 of 6 numbers win a prize. Lotto is a high jackpot game, and players who match all 6 numbers win a million dollar prize. Lotto jackpots start at \$1 million and increase every drawing in which no one matches all six numbers. The largest Lotto jackpot was \$27 million won in 1992. Lotto sales were \$42.3 million in calendar year 2003.

{ Cash 5 }

Introduced in 1996, Cash 5 plays like Lotto, yet offers better odds of winning. Cash 5 sales were \$1,3.8 million in 2003. Players select five numbers from a field of 32 possible numbers. If a player matches 2, 3, 4 or 5 of 5 numbers, they win a prize. Drawings are held six nights a week, every night except Sunday. The top prize in the game is \$20,000. Colorado

Proceeds

Every year thousands of projects are made possible with funds generated from the Colorado Lottery. To date, more than \$1.4 billion has been generated for parks, recreation, open space and environmental projects. In 2003, the four funds that received Lottery proceeds were:

{ Conservation Trust Fund }

Local parks and recreation providers—towns, cities, counties and special districts-receive money from this fund based on population. More than \$41.5 million was distributed through the Conservation Trust Fund in calendar year 2003 for open space and land acquisitions, equipment purchases, facility development, park maintenance, and renovation or restoration of local facilities.

{ Colorado Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation }

Colorado's 40 state parks use Lottery money for open space and land acquisitions, trail system construction and maintenance, equipment and facility purchases, and maintenance and renovation of state parks facilities. Approximately \$10.4 million was distributed to Colorado State Parks in 2003.

Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund }

Established in 1992, this fund includes environmental programs, improvements to parks and recreation facilities, wildlife preservation, and acquiring open space. More than \$48.1 million was distributed to Great Outdoors Colorado in calendar year 2003.

{ School Health and Safety }

The passing of Referendum E (which allows the Lottery to participate in multi-state games such as Powerball) changed the current proceeds distribution formula. The Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund receives up to 50 percent of Lottery proceeds, however, this fund is capped at \$35 million (in 1992 dollars) according to the consumer price index. Under this new legislation, spillover from the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund, which was formerly designated to the General Fund, will be used to address health and safety issues in public schools. To date, more than \$12.2 million has been distributed for School Health and Safety.
