To the General Assembly and the Controller of the State
of Colorado:

Pursuant to section 13-30-103(1)(k)(I), Colorado Revised
Statutes 1972, as amended, the State Court Administrator has
determined and hereby certifies the annual salaries of judges
of the county court in Class C and Class D counties and of all
special associate, associate, and assistant county judges, for
the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1982. This determination
is based upon the following formula, established by the cited
statute:

The following table sets forth the location, the average number of terminations for the three years ending December 31, 1981, in each location, and the salary, based upon the formula set forth above, to be paid to the judge in that location for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1982. The salaries listed below for San Juan, Ouray, Jackson, Conejos, Morgan, Phillips, Crowley, and Elbert Counties reflect adjustments due to take effect at the beginning of the new term of office, January 11, 1983. The adjustments are made as a result of a decrease in the average number of terminations which, by statute, must be made, at the beginning of a new term of office.
