Concerning Pretrial Service Program Requirements

In accordance with SB 00-192 and Section 16-4-105 (3) (e), C.R.S., each pretrial service program is required to provide an annual report to the State Judicial Department no later than November 1 of each year for inclusion in a combined annual report to be presented to the House and Senate Judiciary Committees.

The combined report is to include the following information:

- (1) The number of interviews conducted with defendants
- (2) The number and nature of recommendations made

- (3) The number of defendants under pretrial release supervision who failed to appear; and
- (4) Any additional information the State Judicial Department may request.

As of November 1, 2004, eleven counties provided information. The accompanying table represents the combined information provided by pretrial service programs in (insert county names) Counties. As can be seen, the different pretrial service programs use varying language to describe recommendations they make to the courts and/or bond status.

This report is an effort to compile information in compliance with SB 00-192, however the Judicial Department has no administrative authority regarding pretrial programs.

Counties filed additional narrative reports describing local activities and data collection issues specific to their jurisdiction. These reports are on file and available to the General Assembly.
