To ensure high quality attorney services the OCR uses a comprehensive evaluation strategy to ensure compliance with OCR practice standards and the Chief Justice Directive 04-06 (CJD). As part of that evaluation the OCR obtained 349 surveys from judicial officers, conducted 278 reference interviews and completed 194 court observations. Responses that report an answer of strongly agree or agree are noted with "SFS".
