One hygienist took the board in 1939 and passed and no hygienist took the board in 1940 .

During 1939, 911 dentists renewed their registration, 733 were within the state and 178 were practicing elsewhere. There were 10 revocations of licenses for non-payment of dues in 1939. One was revoked for direct violation of the Practice Act, Section 9, Paragraphs 3 and 4, Session Laws of 1935.

During 1940, 922 dentists renewed their registration. Of this number 749 were practicing in Colorado and 173 were practicing elsewhere. We received two requests for reinstatement, both of which were denied. Three licentiates have been suspended for non-payment of their registration.
