These cameras provide current images of local weather at our Division's 13 mountain AWOS locations and at ten mountain airports. In spring 2022, these cameras will be installed at an additional 20 airports statewide, providing you with real-time additional weather context and information. Camera images and other weather and flight planning information can be accessed at WeatherCams.faa.gov.

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Glossary

AGL (Above Ground Level)-Elevation above ground level measured in feet.

<u>ASOS/AWOS</u> (Automated Surface Observation System/Automated Weather Observing System)-Electronic device providing 24-hour, real-time weather information to pilots via phone or direct radio frequency.

ASPH-Runway surface constructed with asphalt.

<u>ATIS</u> (Automatic Terminal Information Service)-Continuous broadcast of local weather and airport conditions utilizing a discrete frequency.

<u>CLNC DEL</u> (Clearance Delivery)-Operating position in the control tower responsible for issuing clearances to pilots.

CONC-Runway surface constructed of concrete.

<u>CTAF</u> (Common Traffic Advisory Frequency)-Frequency designed for airport advisory practices while operating to or from a controlled airport.

<u>DME</u> (Distance Measuring Equipment)-Permits pilots to determine aircraft's distance from a ground station; usually co-located with a VOR or ILS.

<u>FSS</u> (Flight Service Station)-Air traffic facility providing pilot briefings, en route communications, and VFR search and rescue missions.

GRVL-Runway surface consisting of gravel.

Heavy Aircraft weighing more than 12,500 lbs. MGTW.

<u>HIRL</u> (High Intensity Runway Lights)-Runway lighting primarily used on instrument runways and having five-step lighting variance capability.

<u>IFR</u> (Instrument Flight Rules)-Rules governing conduct of aircraft during instrument flight.

ILS (Instrument Landing System)-Precision approach and landing aid.

Light Aircraft weighing less than 12,500 lbs. MGTW.

<u>LIRL</u> (Low Intensity Runway Lights)-Runway lighting system with a one-step variance capability.

<u>MALSR</u> (Medium Intensity Approach Lighting System with Runway Alignment Indicator Lights (RAIL)-Approach lighting system using runway alignment indicator lights with three-step light variance capability.

<u>MGTW</u> (Maximum Gross Takeoff Weight)-Maximum weight approved for the start of a takeoff roll.

<u>MIRL</u> (Medium Intensity Runway Lights)-Runway lighting system with three-step variance capability.

MSL (Mean Sea Level)-Elevation above mean sea level measured in feet.

<u>NDB</u> (Non-Directional Beacon)-Radio navigation beacon that transmits a uniform omnidirectional signal using a low or medium frequency band.

<u>Navaids</u> (Navigational Aids)-Any electronic device used by pilots for navigational purposes.

NSTD Non-Standard

<u>NWS</u> (National Weather Service)-Agency charged with collecting, disseminating, and forecasting weather conditions for the public.

<u>P2L</u>-Two-box PAPI system positioned on the left side of the runway.

<u>P4L</u>-Four-box PAPI system positioned on the left side of the runway.

<u>P2R</u>-Two-box PAPI system positioned on the right side of the runway.

<u>P4R</u>-Four-box PAPI system positioned on the right side of the runway.

<u>PAPI</u> (Precision Approach Path Indicator)-Visual navigation device permitting pilots to judge the aircraft position relative to the glide path.

<u>RCO</u> (Remote Communications Outlet)-Unmanned communication facility used by controllers to communicate between FSS and pilots.

<u>TPA</u> (Traffic Pattern Altitude)-Altitude at which aircraft traffic pattern is to be flown.

TRIL -Tricolor visual approach indicator on the left side of the runway.

UAS - Unmanned Aerial System

<u>UNI</u> (Unicom)-Non-Federal communications facility providing airport information at certain airports.

<u>VASI</u> (Visual Approach Slope Indicator)-Airport lighting system providing vertical guidance to the runway.

<u>V2L</u>-Two-box VASI system located on the left side of the runway.

<u>V2R</u>-Two-box VASI system located on the right side of the runway.

<u>VFR</u> (Visual Flight Rules)-Rules that govern the procedures for conducting flight under visual conditions.

<u>VORTAC</u> (VHF Omnidirectional Range Tactical Air Navigation)-Navaid facility providing VOR azimuth, TACAN azimuth, and TACAN DME at one site; can be used by VOR-DME or TACAN equipped aircraft.

Mountain Flying Safety Information

The following information is to provide guidelines for safe flying in the high country during the takeoff, en route, approach and landing phases of flight. These are the guidelines used by flight instructors and pilots with many years of safe mountain flying experience. The following are conservative guidelines intended for inexperienced mountain pilots. For information about advanced mountain flying training contact the Colorado Pilots Association www.coloradopilots.com or a Colorado flight school offering mountain flying instruction. Information provided by the Colorado Pilots Association.

THE DONT'S OF MOUNTAIN FLYING

LIGHT TWIN AIRCRAFT

- Do not attempt night flight operations, unless on a single engine the aircraft is capable of maintaining at least 16000 feet MSL.
- Do not attempt IFR operations unless a current and qualified two person crew is on board and they have familiarity with the obstruction departure and destination approach and landing procedures.

SINGLE ENGINE AIRCRAFT

- Do not attempt night operations EXTREMELY DANGEROUS
- Do not attempt IFR operations

SINGLE OR LIGHT TWIN ENGINE AIRCRAFT

- Do not attempt mountain flying if the 9,000 and 12,000 foot winds are forecast to exceed 30 knots. Winds aloft may be accompanied by severe turbulence, with downdrafts exceeding the climb capability of the aircraft.
- Do not attempt a takeoff unless the loaded aircraft is at least 10% or more below the FAA certified gross weight, and the CG is within limits.
- Do not attempt a mountain flight unless the ceilings are at least 2,000 feet above the highest terrain
 and visibility is at least 15 miles

Night and IFR operations are best left to airlines, medical evacuation and corporate crews using fully capable and equipped aircraft. All other pilots should operate in day, VFR conditions if safety is to prevail.

THE DO'S OF MOUNTAIN FLYING

- Do plan the fuel load to arrive at the destination with a minimum one hour fuel reserve. Strong crosswinds or a disabled aircraft on the runway may require a diversion to an alternate airport.
- Do plan a definite altitude to be flown on each segment of the flight. Consult the sectional chart.
- From over a plotted checkpoint, turn the aircraft to the next planned magnetic course and make a
 mental note of the observed features along that course. Movement form one ridge line to another
 may be necessary in climbing toward the pass. Some zigging and zagging across the ridge line you are
 following may be needed to remain in the best updraft along a ridge. Do not lose site of the desired
 points along the segment being flown.
- Always file a flight plan, keep a flight log and make position reports at every opportunity. Close flight plan after arrival at the destination.
- · Do have an operable ELT on board.
- Do have a suitable emergency kit to include a supply of water, signal mirror, whistle and extra clothing as appropriate.
- During the summer, terminate flying activities no later than 1:00 PM MDT.
- Do ask for advice and assistance from FBO, FAA personnel, local mountain qualified flight instructors and pilots. These individuals will be friendly and willing to help.

ITEMS FOR EXTRA ATTENTION IN MOUNTAIN FLYING FLIGHT PREPARATION

- Get a complete weather briefing, including pilot reports for your proposed route. Make note of the winds aloft, altimeter settings, surface winds and NOTAMS for all en route airports and destinations.
- Consult POH for takeoff, climb and ceiling capabilities of the aircraft being flown. When calculated climb rates are less than 200 feet/NM. do not depart.
- A high density altitude may prevent you from reaching the altitude listed in the POH as the service ceiling.

ENGINE START

• For normally aspirated, fuel injected and turbo charged engines, use normal starting procedure and as soon as the engine starts, lean the mixture until the engine runs smoothly. Follow POH for guidance.

RUN U

• Enrich the mixture slightly before beginning the run up. As the run up is completed, advance the throttle to full power and re-lean the mixture as appropriate for the engine being operated. This procedure will provide the proper mixture for takeoff power. Follow POH for guidance.

TAKEOFF

- Taxi into position as near the departure end of the runway as practical, hold the brakes and apply full power. Make a power check and release the brakes.
- Climb out with takeoff power and the best rate of climb IAS to at least 1,000 feet above the departure airport. Some situations may require takeoff power and best rate of climb IAS to 2,500 feet!
- The use of flaps for takeoff may significantly reduce climb performance. Check the POH or make a local inquiry.

EN ROUTE

- Plan to cross all passes and terrain with a minimum 1,000 foot clearance. Know these elevations and use the altimeter - DO NOT GUESS.
- Monitor the rate of climb when climbing across terrain; shuttle climb if necessary.
- Cross all passes at a 45 degree angle so a turn toward lower terrain can be accomplished with 90 to 120 degrees of turning. (Escape Maneuver)
- Reach pass crossing altitude (1,000 feet above pass terrain) 3 miles before reaching the pass.

DESCENT

- Descents may involve rough air. Be prepared to make a slow speed descent at maneuvering speed (but no slower than best angle of climb).
- At pattern altitude, briefly bring the engine to full power while adjusting the mixture to ensure full takeoff power is available if it becomes necessary.

APPROACH AND LANDING


- Study the destination airport data before departure.
- Due to the proximity of terrain or obstacles, some mountain airports have:
- -Left hand patterns for one runway and right hand for the other
- -No descent paths in a valley for a straight in approach
- -Preferred landing and departure runways
- When in doubt ask the tower, if one is in operation, UNICOM or another pilot if one is airborne in the
 vicinity.
- Identify the planned touchdown point on the runway fly the approach at the appropriate airspeed and aircraft configuration
- The appropriate IAS is 1.3 times the stall speed in the configuration for the wing. Excessive speed is undesirable.


MOUNTAIN FLYING IN WINTER


- Winds aloft during winter months are frequently too strong for safe mountain flying in general aviation aircraft.
- Mountain top winds of 40 to 60 knots are not uncommon during the period from December though March. Occasionally wind speeds greater than 80 knots may occur and continue for several days.
- The prudent pilot will check in advance to learn whether the desired services are available at the mountain destination airport.
- Winter operations can be pleasant and safe when all operating requirements are met.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Attend a mountain flying training course which includes a ground school and mountain training flight.
 Such training is available through the Colorado Pilots Association, Denver, CO, American Bonanza Society, Wichita, KS, and others. Individual training is also available through several highly experienced mountain flying instructors in Colorado. Contact the Colorado Pilots Association (303) 367-0670 or visit www.coloradopilots.org for further information.
- · All adverse weather situations are magnified in the mountains.
- Adhere to the weather requirements mentioned previously, or if not possible, park the airplane at an
 airport at the edge of the high country and continue the trip by automobile.
- Nothing you want to do tomorrow is worth risking your life and the lives of your passengers today!
- If a bad operating situation is encountered, proceed to an alternate. The best alternate may be the airport of departure.







Survival Tips

- After an emergency landing, exit the aircraft and give temporary first aid to permit careful removal of passengers from the aircraft.
- Stay away from the aircraft until engines have cooled and spilled fuel has evaporated.
- When everyone is a safe distance from the aircraft, reevaluate injuries and treat as necessary.
- If weather is adverse, make or find temporary shelter while evaluating dangers of aircraft location (fire, avalanche, terrain, water, etc.)
- Stay close to the aircraft for shelter, warmth and signaling, if possible.
- Make sure ELT is working.
- Signal for help. Try to use the aircraft radio by turning down the squelch, turning up the volume and keying the mike. If the radio is operational, listen on a local or ATC frequency. If you hear a transmission, transmit "Mayday, Mayday".
- If you hear a jet, transmit on 121.5 (or transmit blindly) only every 15 minutes to save battery power. If ELT and radio are working, you will hear the ELT signal on 121.5. Do not forget to turn the ELT back on, and leave it on. Conserve your energy and do not spend too much time trying to signal in cold or wet weather conditions.
- Use wings, rudders, maps, tarps, etc. to build and insulate a small shelter for your body to heat. Loss of body heat is loss of energy.
- Think basic needs and utilize the aircraft for warmth, shelter, tools and bedding when possible.
- Build a fire if possible. Smoke and fire can be seen for long distances. Aircraft gasoline is a good resource in starting a fire when only wet wood is available, but BE CAUTIOUS. Soak or pour gasoline on the wood. Ensure gas container is out of reach when igniting the fire. Do not burn paper as it is valuable insulation and bedding source. Gather resources in advance to keep the fire burning for a long period of time.
- Use aircraft insulation and upholstery for over-boots, mittens, bedding, hats and ground insulation.
- Use plastic or waterproof source to melt ice/snow or collect condensation from aircraft surfaces. If it is raining, put plastic in depression in the ground to collect water.
- Rescuers will be looking for smoke, fire, flares, and a downed aircraft. Clear the area around the aircraft, use a mirror for signaling, or form SOS with brush in an open space or in the snow if possible.
- Stay calm, be smart and conserve energy. Survival will depend greatly upon your state of mind.


Wind Components



This crosswind component chart provides at a glance the effect current wind velocity and direction will have upon your take off. For example, a 25 knot wind at a 30 degree angle to either side of the runway heading has the same effect as a 13 knot crosswind. For more details on the effect of wind on your airplane at take off or landing, consult aircraft owner's manual.

Density Altitude Chart

Operational altitude is the altitude of the air at which the aircraft is flown. Aircraft operation, as a result, may be at an altitude greater or less than the actual altitude above sea level.

Colorado Mountain Passes

Berthoud Pass

Route: Denver west to Granby/Kremmling (central mountains). Road elevation 11,315' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS program. This pass follows I-70 to Highway 40 west from Denver. Expect strong downdrafts and limited climb capability when moderate to high winds aloft exist. East to west flight path will be a blind right turn to cross the pass. Mines Peak AWOS 134.325 (OCO) N39°47.9'-W105°46.67'.

Cameron Pass

Route: Fort Collins west to northern mountains (Walden). Road elevation 10,276' MSL. This pass is not visible to any weather reporting stations. N40°31.25'-W105°53.55'.

Cochetopa and North Pass

Route: Located between San Luis Valley and Gunnison area in the center of the state. Road elevations - Cochetopa 10,067' MSL, North 10,149' MSL. The vicinity of these adjacent passes is partially visible from Alamosa and Gunnison weather reporting stations. Elevations and weather often favor these passes over Monarch Pass. N38°10'-W106°36,04'.

Rollins Pass

Route: Denver area to Granby/Kremmling (central mountains). Trail elevation 11,671' MSL. This pass is not visible to any weather reporting stations. This is an open pass with several miles to cross. The trail that crosses is located on the north side of the pass. Expect strong down drafts with winds aloft over 30+kts. N39°56.05'-W105°40.97'.

Cottonwood Pass (Near Buena Vista, CO)

Route: Buena Vista to Taylor Park/Gunnison Area. Trail elevation 12126' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS program. Bald Mountain AWOS 132.05(FBM). This pass is a better alternative than Monarch Pass in moderate winds aloft. N38°49.67'-W106°24.55'.

Cottonwood Pass (Near Eagle, CO)

An alternative to following the river over Glenwood Canyon with better options for emergency landing sites. N39°31.83'-W107°3.49'.

Cucharas Pass

Route: Southeastern plains (Trinidad) to San Luis Valley and Alamosa. Road elevation 9,941' MSL. This pass is not visible to any weather reporting stations. This pass is located west of the Spanish Peaks and leads to La Veta Pass for crossing into the San Luis Valley. N37°19.22'-W105°4.42'.

Cumbres and La Manga Pass

Route: Alamosa to Durango. Road and track elevations - Cumbres 10,022' MSL, La Manga 10,230' MSL. These passes are located on the Colorado/New Mexico state line and are visible from weather reporting station at Alamosa. Cumbres: N37°1.24'-W106°27', La Manga: N37°4.65'-W106°23.17'.

Douglas Pass

Route: Grand Junction to Northwestern Colorado (Rangely). Road elevation 8,268' MSL. The vicinity of the pass is partially visible to weather reporting station at Grand Junction. N39°35.85'-W108°48.19'.

Fremont Pass

Route: Silverthorne/Dillon to Leadville. Road elevation 11,320' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS program. Copper Mountain AWOS 118.075 (CCU). This pass is in an open valley identified by the large Climax Molybdenum Mine N39°21.98'-W106°11.2'.

Hagerman Pass

Route: Leadville to Aspen. Approximate trail elevation 11,960' MSL. This pass is visible to the weather reporting station at Leadville. Elevation, terrain features, and weather often favor this pass over Independence Pass. N39°15.9'-W106°29.03'.

Hayden Pass

Route: East-west pass across the northern Sangre de Cristo Range (Denver to Alamosa). Trail elevation 10,709' MSL. This pass is not visible to any weather reporting stations. Watch for glider and hang-glider activity on the west side of the pass. N38°17.58'-W105°51.04'.

Hoosier Pass

Route: South Park to Breckenridge. Road elevation is 11,539' MSL. This pass is not visible from any airports or weather reporting stations. This pass provides access from the north to South Park. N39° 21.7'-W106° 3.75'.

Independence Pass

Route: Leadville to Aspen. Road elevation 12,094' MSL. This pass is not visible to any weather reporting stations. This pass is narrow with blind turns. Light to moderate winds aloft can make this pass very turbulent. Highway below is open and passable during summer months only. N39°6.53'-W106°33.83'.

<u>Kenosha Pass</u>

Route: Southwest Denver to South Park and Arkansas Valley. Road elevation 10,001' MSL. This pass follows Hwy 285 from Denver to Buena Vista. N39°6.53'-W106°33.83'.

La Veta Pass

Route: Southwest Colorado and Walsenburg to San Luis Valley and Alamosa. Road elevation 9,380' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS program. La Veta AWOS 119.925(VTP). Expect turbulence and up/down drafts during this pass crossing with light to moderate winds aloft. N37°35.59'-W105°12.2'.

Lizard Head Pass

Route: Durango/Cortez to Telluride. Road elevation is 10,222' MSL. Telluride Airport has limited vision of the pass.

Loveland Pass

Route: Denver west to Silverthorne/Dillon (central mountains). Road elevation 11,990' MSL. This pass is not visible to any weather reporting stations. When flying from the east extreme caution should be taken to not continue past HWY 6 when following I-70 due to a box canyon above Eisenhower Tunnel (I-70). Expect strong downdrafts and limited climb capability when light to moderate winds aloft exist. N39°39.82'-W105° 52.75'.

Marshall Pass

Route: San Luis Valley and Salida to Gunnison. Track elevation 10,845' MSL. The vicinity of this pass is partially visible to weather observation in Salida. Weather and terrain often favor this pass over Monarch. N38°23.48'-W106°14.83'.

McClure Pass

Route: Aspen/ Glenwood Springs to Montrose area. Road elevation 8,755' MSL. N39°7.73'-W107°17.03'

Milner Pass

Route: North Denver via Estes Park to Granby. Road elevation 10,758' MSL. This pass crosses Rocky Mountain National Park. Moderate winds aloft will produce turbulence on the east side of the pass. N40°25,20'-W105°43,72'.

Monarch Pass

Route: Salida to Gunnison. Road elevation 11,312' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS Program. Monarch Pass 124.175 (MYP). Expect strong downdrafts and limited climb capability when light to moderate winds aloft exist. Caution: This pass has had a historically high number of crashes. N38°29.8', W106°19.54'.

Mosca Pass

Route: Pueblo to Alamosa over the Great Sand Dunes National Park. Trail elevation 9,740' MSL. Le Veta Pass AWOS 119.925 is located approximately 20 miles to the south. This pass can be used as an alternative to Le Veta Pass when winds are moderate. N37° 43.97'-W105° 27.26'.

Mosquito Pass

Route: Fairplay to Leadville. Trail elevation 13,186' MSL. This pass is not visible to weather reporting stations. High winds aloft will produce turbulence and strong downdrafts. N39°16.88'-W106°11.17'.

North Pass

An alternative to Monarch Pass that is lower with better options for emergency landing sites. N38°13'-W106°34.54'.

Poncha Pass

Route: Salida to Alamosa. Road elevation 9,015' MSL. The pass is visible to Salida weather observations. During moderate winds aloft turbulence can be expected. N38'25.33'-W106' 5,22'.

Rabbit Ears Pass

Route: Kremmling to Steamboat Springs. Road elevation 9,426' MSL. This pass is visible from Steamboat Springs Airport. Use caution when trying to climb over the pass from Steamboat Springs Airport without first gaining sufficient altitude. Expect turbulence and up/down drafts during moderate winds aloft. N40°23.08'-W106°36.7'.

Red Mountain Pass

Route: Montrose to Durango. Road elevation 11,120' MSL. This pass is not visible from any weather reporting stations. Use extreme caution when crossing this pass due to long periods of rugged terrain. During light to moderate winds aloft turbulence and up/down drafts can be expected. N37°53.93'-W107'42.72'.

Tennessee Pass

Route: Leadville to Vail/Eagle. Road elevation 10,424' MSL. This pass is visible to Leadville weather observations. This pass is used for a north/south route through the central mountains of Colorado. N39°19.28'-W106°18.67'.

Trout Creek Pass

Route: South Park to Buena Vista. Road elevation 9,346' MSL. This pass is visible to Buena Vista weather observations. This is one of the lowest routes into the central mountains. N38°54.6'-W105°58.5'.

Vail Pass

Route: Silverthorne/Dillon to Vail/Eagle. Road elevation 10,606' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS program. Copper Mountain AWOS 118.075 (CCU). This pass follows Interstate 70. N39°31.83'-W106°13.03'.

Weston Pass

Route: Fairplay to Leadville. Road elevation 11,960' MSL. This pass is visible to Leadville weather observations. During moderate winds aloft expect turbulence and up/down drafts. This pass has blind turns at both ends. N39°7.88'-W106°10.93'.

Wilkerson Pass

Route: Colorado Springs/South Denver to South Park and central mountains. Road elevation 9,507' MSL. This pass is part of the Mountain AWOS program. Wilkerson Pass AWOS 132.3 (4BM). Wilkerson pass is the main route into the central mountains from the east. N39°2.28'-W105°31.54'.
