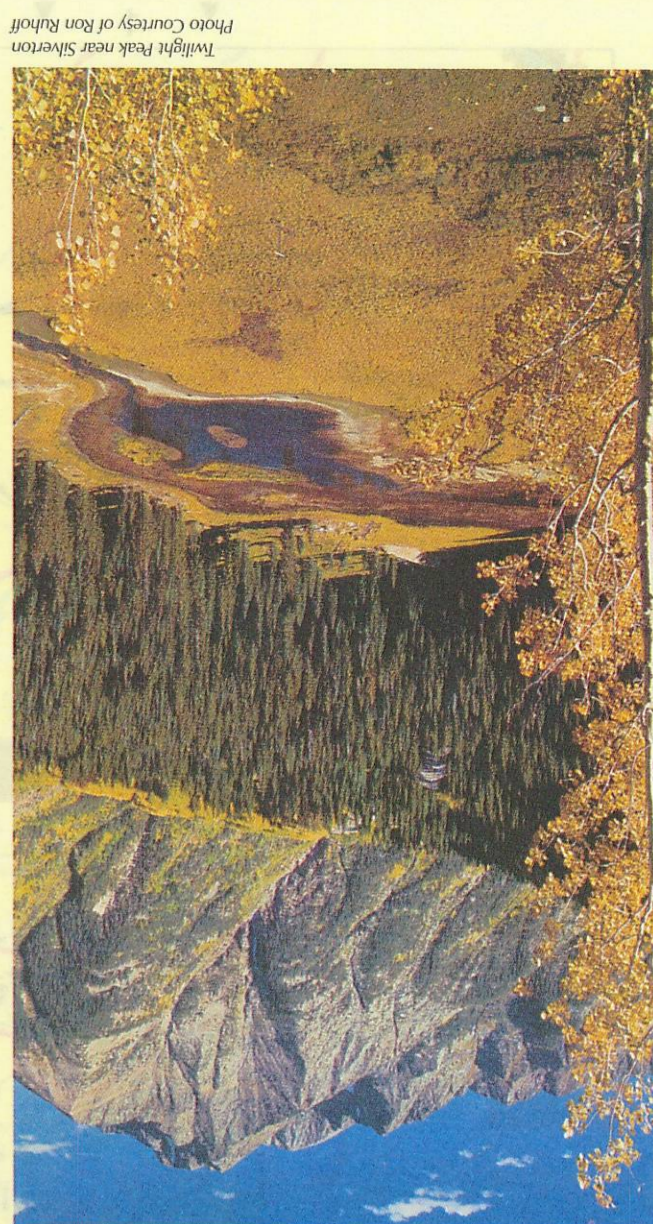

STATE MAP COLORADO STATE MAP

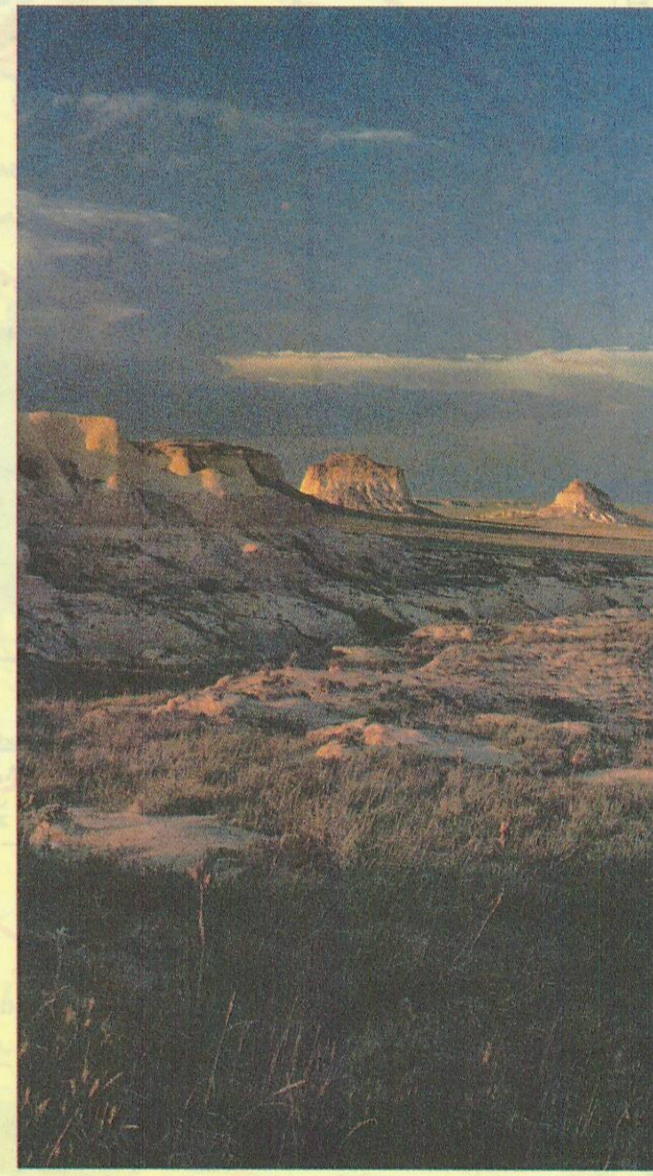

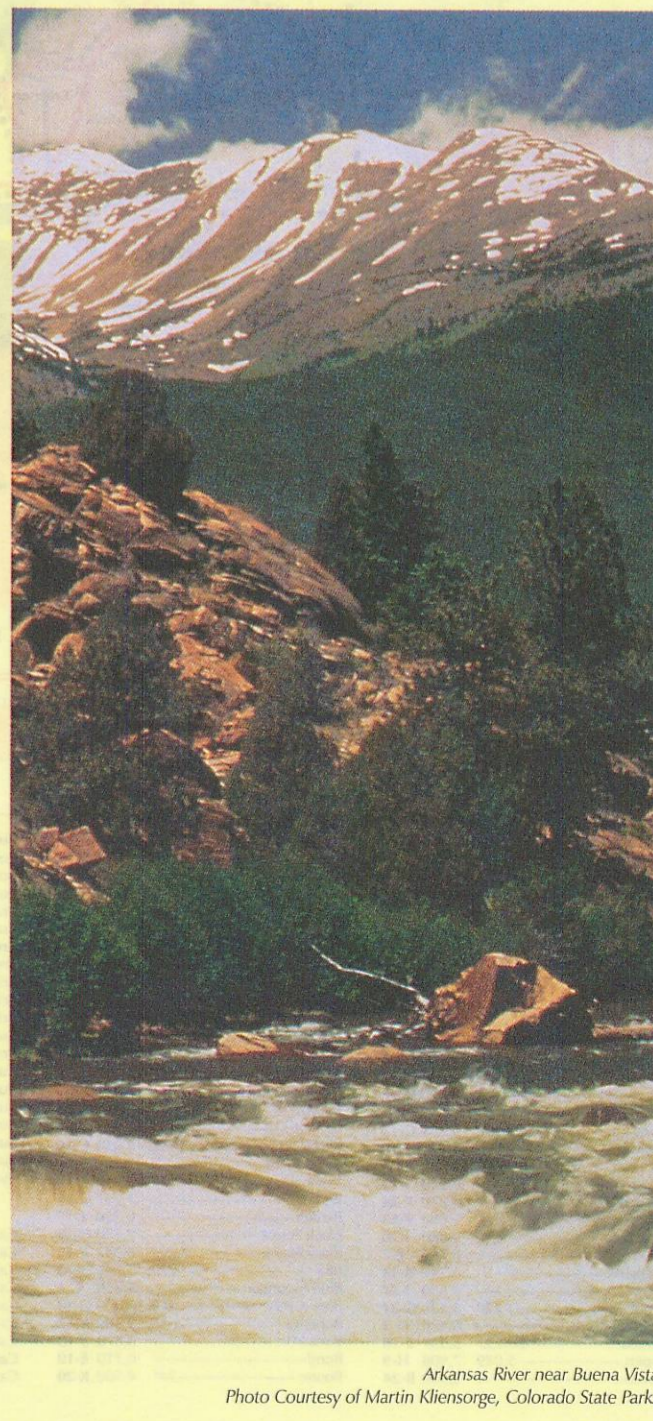
