TRAVEL INFORMATION

Under Colorado Law, children under the age of 4 are required to be in safety seats when riding in a motor vehicle. In addition, drivers and front seat passengers must wear safety belts.

County Roads often provide access to communities, and to scenic and recreation areas. Motorists planning to travel in remote areas, particularly on unpaved roads like the one over Cottonwood Pass west of Buena Vista should make local inquiry concerning road conditions. On the state highway system, U.S. 34 (Trail Road) in Rocky Mountain National Park is closed in winter as is S.H. 62 east of Aspen over Independence Pass.

Snow Tires or Chains frequently are required for use during winter storms or when roads are icy or snow covered. **FOUR WHEEL DRIVE VEHICLES** with adequate tires for the existing conditions also are acceptable. Colorado State Patrol troopers, highway maintenance persons or regulatory signs inform motorists when these requirements are in effect. Transportation Department **SNOWFLAKES** now display flashing **BLUE LIGHTS** in addition to amber lights.
