SUBJECT: First Supplement - FY 2015

• \$216,163– US-50 NEAR PARKDALE, EMBANKMENT REPAIR – TCCRF-Additional funds to award project originally approved for Transportation Commission Contingency Reserve Funds in October 2013. Approximately 1,000 feet of road embankment was washed away due to inadequate drainage and post fire conditions. Repairs will consist of slope reconstruction and additional cross culverts to prevent/control frequent roadway overtopping and road closure. (19897/ 10001...)

\$225,000 – REMOTE PREVENTATIVE AVALANCHE SYSTEMS— Regional Priorities

Program— This action requests additional construction funding from the region's baseline allocation to install automated avalanche control equipment. CDOT has a commitment from the local partner (Winter Springs) for them to fully fund the additional cost. The budget supplement action by the TC allows the project to proceed and the equipment be installed this season. An Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) will be executed to formalize this local funding commitment. Upon completion of IGA the RPP funds will return to the region. RAMP Operations ID #3-51.
