SUBJECT: ELEVENTH BUDGET SUPPLEMENT - FY 2017-2018

### Region 4

\$5,200,000 – 20845 US 85 Resurfacing Eaton to Ault – **Surface Treatment** –The project has significantly overrun project time and funding limits due to delays caused by Differing Site Conditions and plan quantities over-runs. Included in this request are the additional funds to cover the cost of the additional work required for the change of condition, the cost of delays and material over-runs due to inadequate plan quantities. The project encountered extensive unsuitable subsurface materials during excavation and reconstruction operations at numerous locations throughout the project. The cost includes removing unsuitable material and replacing with suitable materials, additional cost for material over-runs and compensation for Compensable Delay §109.10(a).
