SUBJECT: FOURTH BUDGET SUPPLEMENT - FY 2018-2019

Region 1

\$800,000 – **Surface Treatment** – *FY20 HMA Preventative Maintenance*. Chip seal project 21789 was initially put out for bid on December 6, 2017. Bids received were in excess of the budget so the project was not awarded. Additional funds are being requested to align the budget with contractor bids. The amount being requested is greater than \$500,000 and more than 15% of the original approved budget. An increase of this kind requires TC approval before being allocated to the project.
