

Biennial Report

OF THE

TREASURER OF STATE

Denver, Colorado, December 1, 1908.

To His Excellency,
HENRY A. BUCHTEL,
Governor of Colorado.

Sir—As required by law, I have the honor to submit herewith a report of the financial transactions of the State for the biennial period ending November 30th, 1908, together with suggestions for the benefit of affairs pertaining to this Department.

ALL APPROPRIATIONS PAID IN FULL.

Owing to the fact that the revenues for this biennial period have been sufficient to pay all appropriations of the Sixteenth General Assembly, this administration has not been hampered with the serious financial problems that have annoyed many previous administrations.

This satisfactory condition, however, is not due entirely to Legislative conservatism. The last Legislature appropriated \$150,000.00 in excess of the estimated revenue, but the unusually large collections of Inheritance Tax, which amounted to \$386,-\$34.64 during 1907, and \$45,864.89 during 1908, has enabled us to pay all appropriations for the biennial period in full, and have remaining a surplus of \$300,000.00.

CONSERVATISM IN LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS.

My experience during the past four years in the offices of Auditor of State and Treasurer of State prompts me to suggest that careful consideration of the State Auditor's estimate of revenue for the coming biennial period by the incoming State Treasurer and Auditor, in conjunction with the Finance Committee of the Senate and Appropriations Committee of the House, will aid materially in continuing the satisfactory finan-



cial condition of the State, and prevent the entangled and embarrassing conditions resulting from excessive Legislative appropriations.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AUTHORIZING PAY-MENT OF OUTSTANDING WARRANTS.

The Sixteenth General Assembly enacted a bill submitting to the people an amendment to the Constitution authorizing the funding of the ontstanding warrants of the State for the years 1887 to 1897, inclusive, eliminating all accrued interest thereon. It is to be regretted that this amendment failed to carry. The vote stood: For, 26,254; against, 27,352.

In view of the fact that three-fifths of this indebtedness is held by the Investment Funds of the State, and of the further fact that its continued repudiation is a cloud on the credit of the State, it would seem desirable that a measure be passed resubmitting this question to the people, who, after thorough understanding, will doubtless approve by a large majority.

INTEREST ON DEPOSIT OF STATE FUNDS.

Interest on deposits of State Funds during this biennial period amounted to \$65,237.98, an increase of \$13,257.92 over the biennial period of 1905-1906.

FOREST RESERVE CASH FUND.

Cash to the amount of \$28,318.12 has been received from the United States Treasury Department as Forest Reserve Fees to be distributed among the various counties in the State wherein forest reserves are located. A bill was introduced in the Sixteenth General Assembly providing for the apportionment and distribution of this fund, but failed to become a law. In justice to the many counties of the State entitled to their proportionate share of this fund, such a measure should be enacted by the incoming Legislature.

FUNDING OF INSURRECTION CERTIFICATES OF INDEBTEDNESS.

The Sixteenth General Assembly passed an act known as House Bill No. 352 providing for the funding of the indebtedness of the State in suppressing insurrection during the years 1899, 1903 and 1904, by the issue and sale of coupon bonds in the sum of \$900,000.00, running for a period of twenty years, and drawing interest at the rate of three per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually.

This act also provided that the State Treasurer be anthorized to dispose of the same for cash at not less than par and accrned interest. After extensive advertisement of the offering of

these bonds, no bids were received which conformed with this statutory provision, therefore the above certificates of indebted

ness remain unpaid.

In order to make these bonds saleable at par, it will be necessary to increase the rate of interest. The principal and accrued interest to date on these certificates of indebtedness amounts to about \$903,000.00.

LIQUOR LICENSE COLLECTIONS.

The collections of this Department were \$130,925.00 for the biennial period, which is about \$5,000.00 less than the former biennial period, due to the operation of the local option law passed by the Sixteenth General Assembly.

This changed condition would justify a material reduction

in the expenses of the Liquor License Department.

PAYMENT OF CAPITOL BUILDING BONDS.

The final issue of Capitol Building bonds amounting to \$300,000.00 has been paid in full during this biennial period.

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES.

The general laws of the State of Colorado designate the State Treasurer as the custodian of standards of weights and measures, and also requires that each Board of County Commissioners shall procure duplicate standards of weights and measures, and annually appoint a county inspector of weights and measures, etc.

After making diligent search in the Capitol Building, I discovered stored in the sub-basement a set of standards of weights and measures which were procured from the United States

Bureau of Standards by some former Treasurer.

Our legislation on this important subject is obsolete and ineffective, and after communicating with local authorities in the cities, towns and counties throughout the State, I find very lax conditions existing regarding supervision of weights and measures. Few Boards of County Commissioners comply with the law regarding the appointment of inspectors, and a few towns

and cities have local inspectors.

This is a question in which the public is vitally interested, and in order to particularly safeguard the public interest, I would urge an efficient legislative enactment providing for State supervision of weights and measures, such legislation to be in conformity with the recommendations of the United States Bureau of Standards and the Conference of the State Sealers of Weights and Measures which is to be held in Washington on December 17th, 1968.


