Balance of \$654,000.00 refunded June 15, 1935, at 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ % leaving at this time one \$500.00 outstanding. This Bond has been called for payment but has never been presented. Interest ceased June 15, 1935. Sinking Fund June 30, 1938, \$500.00.

## INSURRECTION REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1935

Issued June 15, 1935, as refunding the 1914 Insurrection Bonds, at 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ %.
