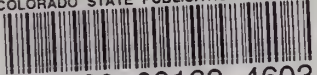

LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

Honorable John A. Love, Governor
and
The General Assembly of the
State of Colorado

Gentlemen:

In conformity with Article 4, Section 17 of the State Constitution and Chapter 3-6-1 (6) C.R.S., 1953, as amended, I submit herewith the Twelfth Annual Report of the Treasury Department, covering the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963.

The Constitution and statutes of Colorado define the general duties of the State Treasurer. He serves only for four years and cannot become his immediate successor. He is custodian of all state moneys and funds, coming into his hands, and all securities left with him in trust. He is a member of the State Board of Equalization, State Board of Canvassers, and Public Employes Retirement Board.

He makes quarterly reports to the Governor, and submits to the Governor and to each person elected to the General Assembly, a detailed statement of the condition of the treasury and its operations for the preceding fiscal year.

OFFICE OF STATE TREASURER

The State Treasurer has the responsibility of safeguarding the securities deposited with him by the various departments. Investments amount to \$214,582,826.88; held for safekeeping \$6,556,571.68, a grand total of \$221,139,398.56, a net increase of \$33,122,900.00 since January 7, 1963.

Four banks have demand deposits (checking accounts) all in Denver.

Time deposits of operating funds, not needed for immediate use, are carried in 136 State and National Banks in Colorado, evidenced by interest bearing certificates of deposit. These deposits are secured by legal and acceptable securities, the market value of which shall always exceed by at least ten per cent the amount of the deposit or deposits. In addition deposits are carried in 51 Colorado Savings and Loan Associations (at interest) of \$10,000.00 each guaranteed by the Federal Savings and Loan Corporation; also invested in United States short term treasury bills, and finally Building Fund Anticipation, interest-bearing warrants, making a grand total of \$97,297,517.00 short term interest-bearing investments, which produced total interest of \$3,030,244.78 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1963.

The office has four Divisions: The Executive Division, Cashier's Division, Accounting Division, and Bond and Securities Division.

The balance of all state and federal funds at the end of June 1963 was \$112,548,200.34 compared with \$122,466,116.91 a year ago.

Total receipts for the period were \$583, 420,741.84, balance from the previous year of \$122,466,116.91 or a grand total of \$705,886,858.75, less disbursements of \$593,338,658.41 leaving a cash balance June 30, 1963 of \$112,548,299.34.

The Highway Revenue Anticipation Warrants, which are obligations against state highway funds only, have been reduced from \$24,240,000.00 to \$21,890,000.00 during the period covered in this report.

The warrant section of the office has handled 771,586 state warrants during the year ending June 30, 1963. On a monthly basis this is 64,257 warrants each 30 days. The above figures include 441,632 Income Tax refund warrants and 17,620 Motor Fuel fund warrants.

Through careful and economical administration the Treasury Department was able to turn back \$1,126.55 to the General Fund the past fiscal year.

It has been a pleasure to have served another year as Treasurer of the great State of Colorado. May I express my appreciation of the splendid co-operation extended to this office by state departments, and especially to my fellow workers, whose efficient assistance and uniform courtesy have given me great pleasure indeed.
