Gentlemen:

I have the honor to submit the Sixteenth Annual Report of the Treasury Department in accordance with Section 17, Article 4 of the State Constitution and Chapter 3-6-1 (g) C.R.S., 1963 as amended, covering the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966.

The Constitution and statutes of Colorado define the general duties of the State Treasurer. His term is for four years. He is custodian of all state moneys and funds, coming into his hands, and all securities left with him in trust. He is a member of the State Board of Equalization, State Board of Canvassers, and Public Employees Retirement Board.

He makes quarterly reports to the Governor, and submits to the Governor and to each person elected to the General Assembly a detailed statement of the condition of the treasury and its operations for the preceding fiscal year.

This will be my last year to serve as Treasurer of the great State of Colorado. May I express my appreciation of the splendid co-operation extended to this office by state departments, and especially to my fellow workers whose efficient assistance and uniform courtesy have given me great pleasure indeed.

OFFICE OF THE STATE TREASURER

The State Treasurer has the responsibility of safeguarding the securities deposited with him by the various state departments, authorities, and divisions. Investments amount to \$294,125,427.95; held in safekeeping \$6,525,315.37, a grand total of \$300,650,743.32, a net increase of \$111,003,453.71, since January 7, 1963.

Four banks have demand deposits (checking accounts), all in Denver.

Time deposits of operating funds not needed for immediate use, are carried in 182 State and National banks in Colorado, evidenced by interest bearing certificates of deposit. These deposits are secured by legal and acceptable securities, the market value of which shall always exceed by at least 10% of the amount of the deposit or deposits. In addition, deposits are carried in 52 Colorado Savings and Loan Associations (at interest) of \$10,000.00 each, guaranteed by the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation; also invested in United States short term treasury bills and finally Building Fund Anticipation interest bearing warrants, making a grand total of \$97,691,176.22 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966.

The office has four divisions: Executive Division, Assistant Treasurer Division, Accounting Division, and Bond and Securities Division.

The balance of all State and Federal funds at the end of June 30, 1966 was \$112,768,960.08, compared with \$85,093,404.83 a year ago. Total receipts for the period were \$775,616,810.64, balance from previous year \$85,093,404.83, or a grand total of \$860,710,215.47, less disbursements of \$747,941,255.39, leaving a cash balance June 30, 1966 of \$112,768,960.08.

The Highway Revenue Anticipation Warrants which are obligations against State highway funds only, have been reduced as follows: Series of 1956-57-58-59 were reduced from \$17,415,000.00 to \$15,205,000.00, a reduction of \$2,210,000.00. The Highway Revenue Anticipation Warrants Series of 4/1/63 for \$18,410,000.00 reduced to \$16,780,000.00, a reduction of \$1,630,000.00. The entire proceeds from the sale of the 4/1/63 series are invested in U. S. Government Bonds and held in escrow by the Colorado National Bank to secure payment of the entire outstanding balance of the 1956-57-58-59 series. The Highway revenues previously used to retire the 1956-57-58-59 series are now applied to retire the 4/1/63 series.

The warrant section of the office has handled 1,119,751 state warrants during the year ending June 30, 1966. On a monthly basis this is 93,313 warrants and 41,101 motor fuel refund warrants.
