#### FUNCTION AND DUTIES OF THE TREASURER

The Constitution and statutes of Colorado define the general duties of the State Treasurer. It is an elective office for four years. The Treasurer receives all state moneys, invests cash funds, apportions funds for various local assistance programs to counties, cities and towns, is custodian of securities held in safekeeping for various state agencies, and services revenue bonded indebtedness outstanding.

The Treasurer is a member of the State Board of Equalization, State Board of Canvassers, Public Employees' Retirement Board and Public Records Advisory Committee.

Quarterly reports are made to the Governor for publication; the Governor and each person elected to the General Assembly are furnished with a detailed statement of the condition of the Treasury and its operations for the preceding year.

#### ITEMS OF SPECIAL INTEREST 1969 - 1970

- ✓ The Treasurer is pleased to report, in the past fiscal year, an all time high return of \$11,267,137 on investments. This amount is 3.33% of the General Fund Revenue — an increase of \$4,160,582, or 59% over the previous fiscal year's earnings.
- ✓ Time Certificates of Deposit issued by 212 Colorado Banks totaled \$69,605,000 at the end of the fiscal year an increase of \$24,490,000 from January 10, 1967.
- ✓ During the fiscal year 8 Million Dollars have been added to the Special Certificate of Deposit Program, bringing the total to 25 Million Dollars. These Special Certificates of Deposit are in units of 1 Million Dollars and are negotiated on a bid basis.
- Deposits in the 53 Colorado Chartered Savings and Loan Associations were increased to \$20,000.00 each for a total of \$1,060,000. The Colorado Savings and Loan League lent valuable assistance in surveying the associations this past year.
- Investments in United States Treasury Securities, Federal Agency Obligations and Commercial Paper totaled \$97,267,611. These securities are primarily purchased with maturity dates coordinated to meet cash requirements.
- Warrants processed through the Treasurer's office tallied 1,451,391.
- Notable changes affecting the office include:

Mrs. Julia E. Swearingen was appointed January 1, 1970 as Deputy State Treasurer, succeeding Mrs. Dorothy McRae. Mrs. McRae served as Deputy from January 10, 1967 through December 31, 1969.

- Effective July 1, 1969 the issuing of United States Savings Bonds for 3,000 State employees was transferred from this office to the Colorado State Bank. The issuance is now completely computerized. This was in concurrence with the recommendation from the Colorado Efficiency and Economy Committee.
- ✓ Treasurer's service on committees, in addition to those prescribed by law, included:

Member of the Governor's Revenue Estimating Committee.

Member of the Investment Committee of the Public Employees' Retirement Association.

Chairman of the United States Savings Bond Drive for State Employees - 1970.

Chairman for all State Agencies, 1969-1970 United Way Campaign.

Member, Board of Trustees, Mile High United Fund 1970.

February 5-7, 1970, Host for Western States Treasurers' Annual Conference comprised of the 13 Western States. Honorable Michael A. Mirabelli, Treasurer, State of Nevada, chaired the conference. Conference theme was "Economics 1970". Among the speakers were: Dr. Maurice Mann, Assistant Director, United States Bureau of the Budget; Robert H. Bethke, Chairman, Executive Committee, Discount Corporation; Glenn Browne, Fiscal Agent, U. S. Government Agencies.

Members of the Advisory Committee continued to contribute valuable advice to the Treasurer.


