## Poudre River Bulletin.

July 9 to 15, 1902.—The flow of the river has gradually fallen during the past week. The average for the week has been 398 cubic feet, which includes some water from other watersheds, while the normal for the same time has been 957 cubic feet.

The weather during the past week has been warm and dry, only .17 in. of precipitation having fallen at the college. Rains in the mountains have not been sufficient to affect the streams during the past week.
