## Poudre River Bulletin.

Oct. 8 to 14.—The river during the week has been considerably better than normal, with an average of 183 cubic feet per second as compared with 130 cubic feet per second for the normal. This also is better than for the corresponding week since the years 1895-6.

During the week .88 inches of precipitation fell, making the total to date 17.39 inches, while the normal rainfall for the year to November 1 is but 13.74.
