Poudre River Bulletin.

Oct. 14 to 21, 1902.—The river has been nearly constant during the past week, averaging 137 cubic feet per second for the entire week. This is a little above the normal which is 110 cubic feet per second for the same period of time. We have no record of the flow for the corresponding week in 1901.

Many of the ditches are not taking water from the river, although some of the larger ones are continuing to take some water.
