The figures are classified by Primary funding source (i.e. the Federal figures include both projects that are directly funded by the Federal Government as well as those Federal projects passed through another non-federal entity).

The change in expenditures from 2009 to 2010 is attributed to a \$10.7M decline in Colorado State Forest Service expenditures in 2010.

The economic downturn is evident in the decline in expenditures sponsored by non-federal sources.

Foundation funding expenditures are on an upward trajectory in part due to increased attention to relationship building.

The large increase in expenditures in 2007 over that of 2006 can primarily be attributed to the continued construction of the NIH Regional Biocontainment Laboratory.
