


PROPOSALS SUBMITTED FOR EXTERNAL FUNDING ALL UNITS – NUMBER AND AMOUNT




PROPOSALS SUBMITTED FOR EXTERNAL FUNDING ALL UNITS – AMOUNT AND % CHANGE








AWARDS (OBLIGATIONS) RECEIVED FROM EXTERNAL SPONSORS – AMOUNT AND PERCENT CHANGE







FISCAL YEAR 2016






EXTERNAL FUNDING BY COLLEGE FY 2016 AND FY 2017


FY 2016 TOTAL AWARD (OBLIGATED) AMOUNT \$282M




FY 2017 TOTAL AWARD (OBLIGATED) AMOUNT \$314M


