



FY 2016 Award, Proposal and Expenditure Highlights




PROPOSALS SUBMITTED FOR EXTERNAL FUNDING – ALL UNITS




PROPOSAL AMOUNT REQUESTED AND PROPOSALS GREATER THAN \$1 MILLION




PROPOSAL AMOUNT AND PI, CO-PI, KEY PERSON TEAM SIZE




CSU SUCCESS RATES FOR NSF AND NIH PROPOSALS COMPARED WITH AGENCY SUCCESS RATE











Proposal Dollars by College





PROPOSAL STATISTICS BY SPONSOR TYPE







TOTAL OBLIGATED AMOUNT AND OBLIGATIONS GREATER THAN \$1M




EXTERNAL FUNDING BY COLLEGE FY 2015 AND FY 2016







AVERAGE OBLIGATED AMOUNT – ALL SPONSORS




OBLIGATION STATISTICS BY COLLEGE




OBLIGATION STATISTICS BY SPONSOR TYPE




